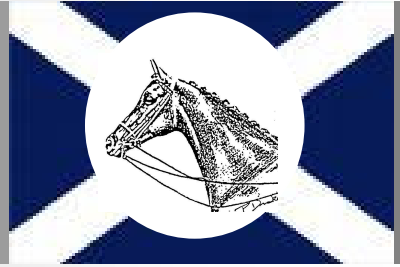

BSPS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2009 BSPS Championships Show to be held 26th – 30th Aug 2009 at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prizewinners only in Classes 3-9,31-35,36-37,41-43,41-43,52 and 54-57 and the highest placed 133cms in the 138cms Show Pony class, and the highest placed 143cms in the 148cms Show Pony class, and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in Classes 1-2,10,15-20, 27, 39, 53, 47-49 will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 23. *Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the championship they qualify for.*

THE BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prizewinners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden or Open Show Pony or Open Show Hunter Pony or Open Working Hunter Pony classes and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in the Intermediate SRT, Intermediate SHT, Intermediate Working Hunter classes will qualify. Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered to compete in these classes.

BSPS CHALLENGE

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, the highest placed pony in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony and the Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH classes, Herotage Open LR, FR, Ridden and WHP, that has not qualified for the 2009 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying for the BSPS Challenge a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify in the Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open SP, Lead Rein of Hunter Type Open SHP, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, Open WHP, Int SRT,SH and WH, Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden, and Open Heritage WHP classes, and all mixed height Open Classes.

BSPS CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Mini WHP, the Champion Open Show Pony, the Champion Open WHP/WH, the Champion SHP, the Champion Mini Heritage, the Champion Ridden Heritage and the Champion Heritage Working Hunter Pony will qualify.

BSPS BEST RIDER

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Open Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Open SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes (**eligible riders must wear an armband**) will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show.

SCOTTISH SHOW PONY AND SHOW HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIPS

The two highest placed Scottish Ponies (Owned, Ridden & Produced by Scottish Branch Members) from all Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes, including Open & Novice, Intermediates and Lead Rein & First Ridden will receive a Rosette and qualify for the above finals which will be judged in Ring 1 on completion of the HOYS Intermediate Championship.

SCOTTISH WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

The first four prizewinners in Classes 55 to 58 will qualify to compete in the Scottish WHP Championship to be held at the BSPS Scotland's Summer Finale **on 19th September 2009.**

REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Owners and riders must be BSPS Members and pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBBON and HOYS. At this show this includes all Open Show Pony classes (3-5), Open Show Hunter Pony classes (6-8), Intermediate classes (1, 2, 9, 26, 27), Lead Rein and First Ridden classes (36, 37), Open Working Hunter Pony classes (41-54). Owners and riders must be Member of SHB(GB) and horses must be on the 2009 Show Hunter Register or be in possession of a Day Ticket to compete in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight and Working Hunter classes (11 -14, 45).

All other classes are open to all competitors and no annual membership/registration to any society is required to enter or compete. In all Heritage M&M classes and the Anglo & Partbred Arab classes all animals must be registered in their relevant Breed Society stud book.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW, NEC BIRMINGHAM 7th to 11th October 2009

This Show is a qualifier for the Horse of the Year Show. Only one pony in each of LR Show Hunter Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate SRT, Intermediate SHT, Intermediate Working Hunter classes qualifies, the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first five ponies placed in each class will qualify. In the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight and Working Hunter classes the highest placed horse in each class will qualify to enter at the HOYS unless it has already done so, in which case the second horse will go forward. No horse lower than second will qualify.

BSPS Novice Definition

A Pony of six years old and over that has three BSPS Affiliated Open or Restricted Open or Pretty Polly Open wins where there is a first prize of £5 or over or placed 1st – 5th at RIHS or HOYS in a particular class is no longer eligible for Novice in that particular class for the remainder of its career.

SPORTS HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

This Show is affiliated to SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN and all Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's Rules. The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight and Working Hunter classes (11-14,45) are qualifying events for this year's **HOYS** (7th – 11th October 2009), and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes are also qualifiers for **The National Hunter Supreme Championship Show** to be held at Addington Manor on 8th & 9th September 2009, with the 1st, 2nd & 3rd horses in each class qualifying for the final. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society. The Society offers a Temporary Registration to competitors who wish to compete at ONE qualifying show for a fee of £10 (*Horses need to be on the Basic Identity Register before they can be on the Show Register or have a Temporary Registration*). If the horse subsequently qualifies then they will need to complete their full registration before the Championship Show for which the horse has qualified and the £10 fee will be refunded. **HOYS Qualifying Classes:** In the Small, Lightweight, Middleweight, and Heavyweight classes (11-14) the highest placed horse will qualify to enter unless it has already done so, in which case the second horse will go forward. No horse lower than second place will qualify. In the Working Hunter Class (45) the highest placed horse will qualify to enter unless it has already done so, in which case the second horse will go forward unless it has already done so in which case the third horse will go forward. No horse lower than third place will qualify.

THE BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE

The Qualifier from each of Classes 11-14, & 45 will be the highest placed horse (not already qualified) that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, i.e. with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding. The horse need not be registered to qualify but **MUST** be on the IDHS(GB) Registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show on 19th & 20th September 2009 at Weston Lawns Equestrian Centre, Bulkington, Coventry. Each Qualifier will receive a rosette and £10 voucher from Blue Chip. **IN THE FINAL**, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Trophy and Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, £100 prize money plus a Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Pure Bred and a Trophy to the highest placed under 15.2hh.

NPS SCOTLAND QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifying round for the NPS Scotland / Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden M&M Final (the 2 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from Classes 15-18 will qualify) and the NPS Scotland / Scottish & Northern Equestrian Magazine M&M WHP Final (the 3 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from

Classes 49-51 will qualify) to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 21st August 2009. The rules for these competitions are as follows:

1. Ponies may only qualify once for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland ponies to be registered in the main body of their respective stud book.
3. Qualification can go as far down the line as necessary
4. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card, duly signed by the judge at the time of qualifying, with your entry form.
5. The exhibitor must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Final.

CHAPS (UK) QUALIFIER

This show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society UK. Both the owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be showing members and the horse/pony must be registered with the Society BEFORE this show for the qualification to be valid except Ponies UK/BSPS Qualifiers where membership/registration if not already in place MUST be made within 14 days of qualification for qualification to be valid. See CHAPS members' handbook or www.chapsuk.com for rulings.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 4th – 6th September 2009. Shows held on or after date of Championships Show will count as 2010 Qualifiers. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies UK Summer Championships will be held 12th-15th August 2009. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers 24-26. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook or visit www.chapsuk.com All stallions entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS UK. ID cards must be carried in the ring for inspection. Foals born within current year are not eligible to compete in qualifying classes.

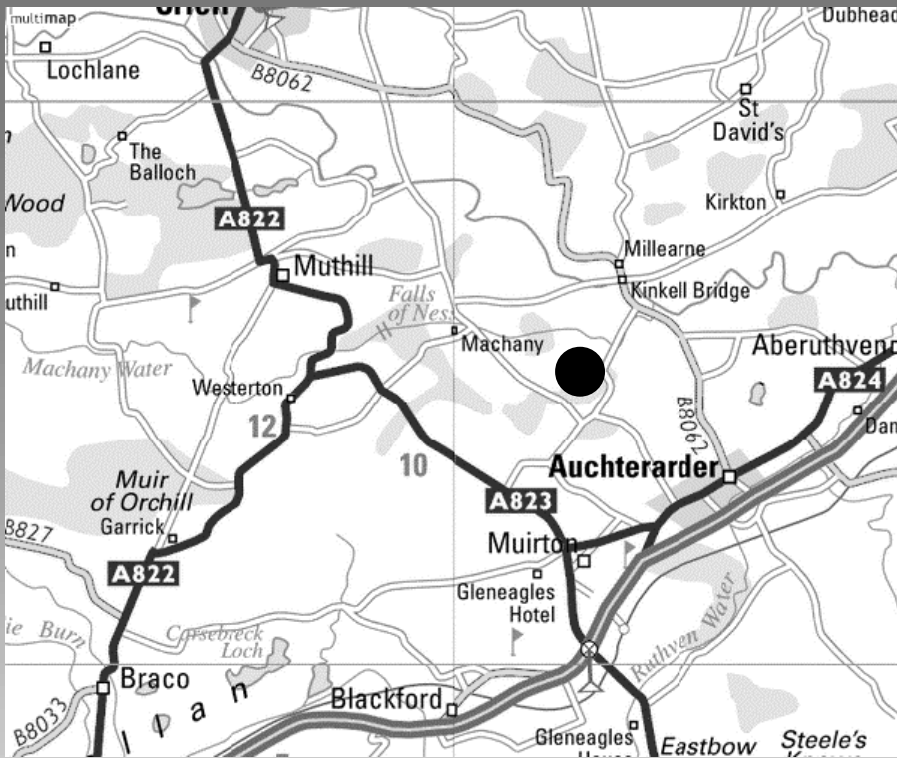
