This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

All Rules as per the 2010 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook, except for any new or amended rules as Included In this Schedule.

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

All classes, apart from the Tiny Tots, Cradle Stakes and Lead Rein of Hunter Type are qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Winter Championships. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in the Novice Classes and 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in Mixed Height Novice Classes will qualify. In the Open Classes the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Open and the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed Open and the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. (Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed seven days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid J.M.B. Certificate before the day of the Championship they qualify for.

HERITAGE QUALIFICATION

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies in the Novice Classes will qualify and. in the Mixed Height Novice Classes 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th prizewinners will qualify. In the Open Classes the qualifications will be awarded to the three highest placed Restricted animals and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Open animals in each class, and in the Mixed Height Open Classes the four highest placed Restricted animals and the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed Open animals will qualify (Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the B.S.P.S are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

B.S.P.S. RESTRICTED OPEN QUALIFICATION

Any animal that has qualified for the Open classes at the RIHS or HOYS in 2009, or the current year, is not eligible for the Restricted qualification in the Open classes.

Rulings for British Show Horse Association Classes

Held under the rules of the BSHA. Horses must be registered with the Association and all owners, exhibitors and riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years and over. Classes 41, 42, 43, 44, 45 & 46 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner in each section will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified, the second will qualify, If the first and second have already qualified then the third will forward. Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain competitions of their affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show.

The BSHA offer an Award of Merit, Amateur and Young Rider Rosette in each open class and a championship rosette for each section. The highest placed Amateur Home Produced exhibit in all RIHS qualifying classes will receive a Blue Chip rosette and £5 money off voucher. The highest placed exhibitor will need to contact Sarah Butler by email sarah@bluechipfeeds.com or on 0114 266 6200 (max one rosette to be won at a RIHS qualifier per horse, otherwise the award will be passed down the line) Exhibitors are asked to send a copy of their signed card to the office with a large stamped addressed envelope to claim these rosettes, 42p postage.

*******BSHA RISING STAR QUALIFIER*******

Any exhibitor placed in the first three in the Open Intermediate SRT classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Rising Stars Championship at the National Championships on September 10th & 11th 2010 at Addington. No qualifying card required.

QUALIFICATION FOR THE BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION – NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The three highest placed in Classes 41 & 42 will qualify to compete in the “CLASSIC SUPREME COB” Class at the National Championship Show on September 10th & 11th 2010. The three highest placed in Classes 45 & 46 will qualify to compete in the “CLASSIC SUPREME HACK” Class at the National Championship Show in September. The three highest placed in Classes 43 & 44 will qualify to compete in the “CLASSIC SUPREME RIDING HORSE” Class at the National Championship Show in September. Classes are held under the Rules and jurisdiction of the British Show Horse Association.

All Exhibitors MUST be registered with this Association or non-members may purchase a maximum of two day tickets per exhibitor per season from BSHA, which allows you to compete in open affiliated classes but not RIHS classes. Horses on a day ticket do not require a JMB certificate. You Please contact BSHA office to apply for a day ticket.

THE BRITISH SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD ASSOCIATION - QUALIFICATION FOR THE ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW 2010

These Classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are Qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead in July 2010. The 2 highest placed not already qualified from the first three places in Classes 39 & 40 will qualify. No competitor from lower than 3rd place may qualify Classes will be judged under B.S.P.A. Rules, copies of which can be obtained from BSPA 01354 638226 or downloaded from www.bsponline.com . All horses must be Registered and owners and rider's Members of B.S.P.A. prior to the Show. Rider age taken as 1st January. Membership and Qualification Cards must be carried in the ring and produced upon required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Stallions MUST be graded and licensed by B.S.P.A. No rider under 14 years may exhibit a stallion in any class.. CLASSES OPEN TO SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD HORSE/PONIES ONLY.

CHAPS (UK) WINTER RESTRICTED QUALIFIER is open to mares, geldings or stallions, skewbald or piebald four years old or over. Rider any age. Open to all CHAPS (UK) registered horses and ponies who have not previously been placed at HOYS at any time. Both the owner and rider of any exhibit need not be a fully paid up member of CHAPS (UK) at the time of competition, nor must the animal be registered but to validate the qualification, both membership and registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualification.

STATUS AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF ITS SIX YEAR OLD YEAR.

A NOVICE WH SIX YEARS OLD OR OVER THAT WINS THREE OPEN OR
RESTRICTED OPEN WORKING HUNTER CLASSES WHERE A FIRST PRIZE
IS £5.00 OR OVER, WILL IMMEDIATELY BE CLASSED AS AN "OPEN WH"
FOR THE REST OF ITS SHOWING CAREER AND IS NO LONGER ELIGIBLE
FOR NOVICE WH CLASSES EXCEPT THAT ANY QUALIFICATION HELD FOR
