



Cumberland Farmers' Hunt (South) Branch of the Pony Club

OPEN SHOW ~ Saturday 2nd April 2011

To be held at Greenlands Equestrian Centre

Ring 1 (top end of arena) - **HANDY HUNTER** - Start 930 am – 1130pm

This will be open from 930-1130am for competitors to do their round whenever they are free, classes will be split into age groups.

CLASS 1 8 and under (can be assisted),

CLASS 2 9-13

CLASS 3 14 and over.

Round timed – fastest to win with all obstacles completed.

Ring 2 (main part of arena) – **MINI JUMPING/SHOW** Start 9.00 - 1130 am

CLASS 4 – Beginners (can be assisted) jumps cross poles. (One round timed)

CLASS 5 – Expert Beginners. Maximum height 30cm (can be assisted-one round timed)

CLASS 6 – Style and Performance (Flat and Jumps) Riders to ride a very short show (the judge will tell you what show to do) then jump 5 fences of your choice. All will be judged on Style and Performance, normal jumping penalties apply. Can be assisted. (5 jumps cross poles/5 jumps 45cm)

Rings 1 and 2 combined (whole arena) – **SHOW JUMPING** - Start 1200pm approx

Classes: 8,10 &12 - if clear in first round jump shortened course as a jump off – to be jumped straight away.

CLASS 7 Relay jump. 2 riders, 2 ponies/horses. Jump a course, pass a baton, 2nd rider jumps. Judged on total time, any knock downs adds 5 seconds. Jumps approx 45 cm with one joker at 60cm. (if joker jumped clean 10 seconds taken off total time, 10 sec added if faulted).

CLASS 8 Pony/Horse. Max height 55cm

CLASS 9 Pony/Horse. Max height 65cm (Joker at 85cm) if joker jumped 10 secs taken off time if knocked down 10 secs added.

CLASS 10 Pony/Horse Max height 75cm

CLASS 11 Pony/Horse Jumps range from 80cm-100cm. Given 60 seconds to jump as many jumps as possible, 10 points for each jumped clear. Bell will ring at 60 sec, time taken to get to finish will be taken into account it 2 scores the same. Each fence can be jumped twice unless knocked down.

CLASS 12 Pony/Horse Max height 105cm

- Please note age as on the day of the show.
- Rosettes to 6th Place
- Complaints must be made in writing accompanied by £10.00 payable to CFHS to the DC or her representative.

Entry Fees:

£4 for Handy Hunter (classes 1-3)

£5 per rider/class (classes 4 -12)

Entries on day £1 extra

If you competed for the CFHS at either or both the Team Jumps on January 15th or 22nd each class is £3 per rider/horse (this show is the day we won from these 2 competitions and we would like to thank those riders who represented our branch and helped us win)
