RULES & REGULATIONS 1st May 2011

Teams – For the team competitions a team shall be made up of three or four team members from the same school, with the best three scores to count. Should a team be short of a competitor then that team may invite ONE ONLY guest member from another school to ride with them. The guest must ride under their adopted school's colours for the team competitions. A guest may not ride for more than one school team.

1. **All stabling & entries must be in no later than Friday 15th April 2011.**
2. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
3. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
4. The show organisers reserve the right to alter the order or timing of classes, or cancel any class, or event as may be considered necessary.
5. All dogs MUST be kept on a lead at all times within the premises.
6. No motorcycles or ball games are permitted in the premises.
7. Personal cheques will not be accepted. Cash or credit/debit cards only.
8. Entries received without the appropriate fee **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
9. Practice fences will be flagged and must be jumped in the correct direction.
10. The judges' decision is final.
11. All horses & ponies must be 4yrs old & over.
12. Competitors must wear correct clothing & tack in accordance to BSJA rules.
13. Lunging is not permitted in any working area.
14. Objections must be raised in writing to the Show Organisers within 30 minutes of any incident together with a deposit of £100. The deposit will be repaid if the objection is sustained.
15. The Organisers will not accept any legal liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, riders, spectators or any property owned by them. It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to indemnify the Organisers against any legal action that may arise from any cause whatsoever connected with the event.
16. Every competitor from the Girls Schools Association MUST wear a red armband.
17. Hard hats MUST be worn at all times when mounted and in the Young Handlers classes.
18. The event will run strictly in accordance with BSJA Rules.
19. All classes are pre-entry and will have a drawn order.
20. Children under 16yrs must be accompanied by an adult.
21. No assistance will be allowed when competing in the arenas.
22. Excessive use of spurs/whips or other maltreatment anywhere in the show ground will not be tolerated. Offenders may have their entries cancelled and fees may be forfeited.
23. Rosettes to 6th Place in every class.
24. No horse may be ridden by 2 different riders in the same class.
25. Competitors MUST wear either their school tie and/or a numnah with the school name.
26. All competitors MUST be in full time primary or secondary school education.
27. All entry forms must be signed by the schools Chef D'Equipe and Head Teacher.
28. The submission of every entry will be deemed to include acceptance of these conditions.

SHOWJUMPING
Sunday 1st May – Indoor Main Arena
**** HUNTLY/GLAMIS ARENA ****

Start 9.30am Prompt – All classes are pre-entry & drawn order

- Class 1** **Ingliston Novice/Nursery Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
Open to all competitors of school age. Fences 50cms in the first round. If competitors go clear in the 1st Round they go through to the jump off which will not exceed 60cms. Competitors NOT to have won 1st place in another jumping competition. 2 stops will result in elimination
Entry fee £12 including medical
- Class 2** **Ingliston Intermediate Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
Competitors not to have attained their 16th birthday on day of event. Fences 60cms in the first round. If competitors go clear in the 1st Round they go through to the jump off which will not exceed 70cms. 2 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee £12 including medical
- Class 3** **Ingliston Open Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
Open to all competitors of school age. Fences 70cms in the first round. If competitors go clear in the 1st Round they go through to the jump off which will not exceed 80cms. 2 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee £12 including medical
- Class 4** **Ingliston and Craigholme Junior Team Challenge for the Craigholme Trophy**
DRAWN ORDER
Competitors not to have attained their 13th birthday on the day of the event. Fences 50 cms in the 1st round. Teams of 3 or 4 jump in the 1st round. Total of the best 3 scores in each team count to go forward to the jump off which will not exceed 60cms. For the jump off, each team will nominate just one member from that team to compete in the jump off. The member of the team with least faults and fastest time in the jump off wins. 2 stops will result in elimination. Competitors may not jump in Class 5.
Entry fee £12 per team member including medical
- Class 5** **Ingliston and Craigholme Senior Team Challenge for the Craigholme Trophy**
DRAWN ORDER
Open to all competitors of school age. Fences 70cms in the 1st round. Teams of 3 or 4 jump in the 1st round. Total of the best 3 scores in each team count to go forward to the jump off which will not exceed 80cms. For the jump off, each team will nominate just one member from that team to compete in the jump off. The member of the team with least faults and fastest time in the jump off wins. 2 stops will result in elimination. Competitors may not jump in Class 4.
Entry fee £12 per team member including medical

Class 6 **Intro A (2008) 20 x 40m**

Open to all competitors of school age. To be run under British Dressage Rules 2011.
Entry fee £12 including medical

Class 7 **Prelim 10 (2002) 20 x 40m**

Open to all competitors of school age. To be run under British Dressage Rules 2011.
Entry fee £12 including medical

Class 8 **Style and Performance to Music (Will take place in the first available ring)**

Open to all competitors of school age. No height restriction on size of pony or horse. The freestyle performance show must include the following:
Halt/walk on a long rein/ordinary trot serpentine (2 or 3 loop serpentine acceptable). Extended trot on the diagonal/canter serpentine with simple change of lead/extended canter on the diagonal. Show must not exceed two minutes.

Entry fee £12 including medical

Marking as follows: 50 marks – Performance
50 marks – Music

Method of Judging

This class is to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly. Marks are awarded to well trained horses and ponies performing correctly ridden movements in a freestyle manner in an area no larger than 40 x 60m. In the event of a tie, the marks from performance will take precedence. If there is still a tie the judge's decision is final

Classes 6 – 8 will run in numerical order

MINI EVENT

**** TANTALLON ARENA ****

- Class 9 Junior Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or gelding of any height. Rider not to have attained 13th birthday on the day of the event.
Maximum height of fences 61cms (2'0")
Entry fee £12 including medical
- Class 10 Intermediate Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or gelding of any height. Rider not to have attained 16th birthday on the day of the event.
Maximum height of fences 76cms (2'5")
Entry fee £12 including medical
- Class 11 Open Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or gelding of any height. Open to all competitors of school age. Maximum height of fences
92cms (3'1")
Entry fee £12 including medical

Riders may only compete in one class and may ride only one horse/pony

Phase 1	Dressage Test – Attached on separate sheet	70 marks
Phase 2	Working Hunter Jumping	100 marks
Phase 3	Conformation, type and suitability for Eventing	30 marks
	Total	200 marks

Method of Judging

Horses/ponies enter ring individually and complete Phase 1 – the Dressage Test – then proceeding immediately to Phase 2 – the Jumping Phase - then immediately on to Conformation.

There are no set penalties for a pole down or a stop, but 2 stops will result in elimination.

All horses/ponies, unless eliminated, are required to come back without saddles for Phase 3

The Judge does not have to sit at any appointed place for the Dressage test, but may sit at the point they feel most appropriate, according to the design and layout of the arena.

Rules for the Mini Event

Fall or horse/pony/rider anywhere on the course will result in elimination. Boots are permissible in Phase 1 and Phase 2. In the event of a tie, the marks from Phase 2 will take precedence.

Dressage Test

The Dressage Test for this class is attached on the following page.

Mini Event Dressage Test

<u>Item</u>	<u>Marker</u>	<u>Movement</u>
1.	A C	Enter at working trot and proceed down the centre line Track left
2.	HXF F	Change the rein showing a few lengthened strides over X Working Trot
3.	AX XA	Half circle right, 20 metres working trot Half circle right, 20 metres working canter, transition at X
4.	KXM	Change of lead through trot at X
5.	MCH	Working canter left
6.	E K	Working Trot Medium walk
7.	A D G	Turn down centre line Working trot Halt, immobility, salute Leave the arena at Walk

Marks will be awarded for freedom and regularity of paces, harmony and Lightness of horse and rider.

All Young Handler classes are judged on the handlers' presentation and showing technique.

Start 9am Prompt – All classes are pre-entry.

Class 12 Best Turned Out Horse or Pony

Open to all competitors of school age. May be in-hand or ridden. Class may be split depending on entries forward. In addition to Class rosettes, there will be a rosette for best competitor 12 years and under, 15 years and under and 16 years and over.

Entry fee: £12 including medical

Class 13 Family Horse or Pony

Open to all competitors of school age. To be shown under saddle. Class may be split depending on entries forward. Snaffle bridles must be worn. In addition to Class rosettes, there will be a rosette for best competitor 12 years and under, 15 years and under and 16 years and over.

Entry fee £12 including medical

Class 14 Young Handlers

Open to all competitors of school age. To be shown in hand. Classes may be split depending on entries forward. In addition to Class rosettes, there will be a rosette for best competitor 12 years and under, 15 years and under and 16 years and over.

Entry fee £12 including medical

Class 15 Coloured Horse or Pony

Open to all competitors of school age. Horse or pony may be of any height. Class may be split depending on entries forward. May be shown ridden or in hand. In addition to Class rosettes, there will be a rosette for best competitor 12 years and under, 15 years and under and 16 years and over.

Entry fee £12 including medical

Class 16**Craigholme RDA Invitation Class for the Craigholme Invitation Cup**

RDA Handy Pony competitions open to invited RDA Groups. Open to all competitors of primary and secondary school age.

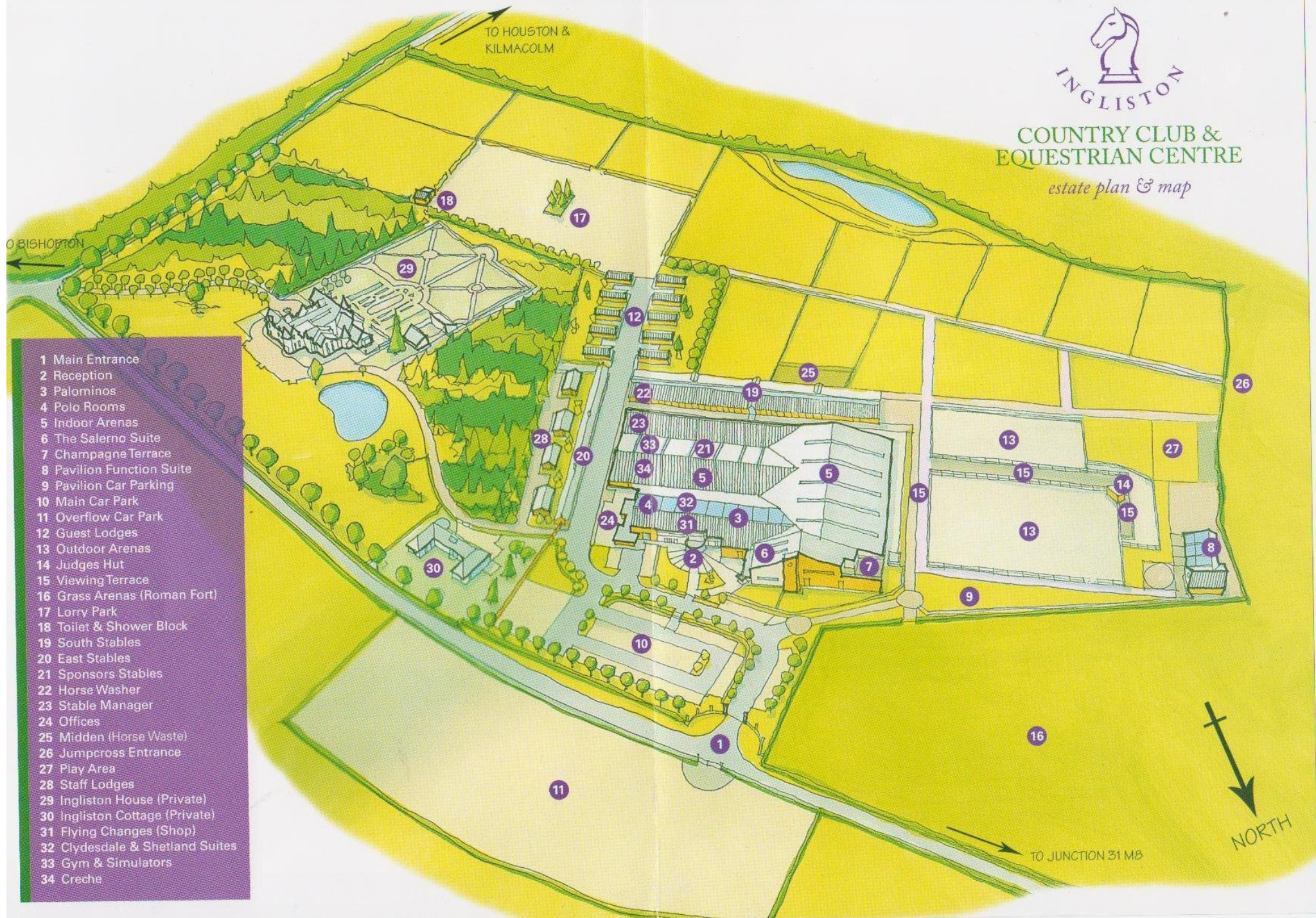
