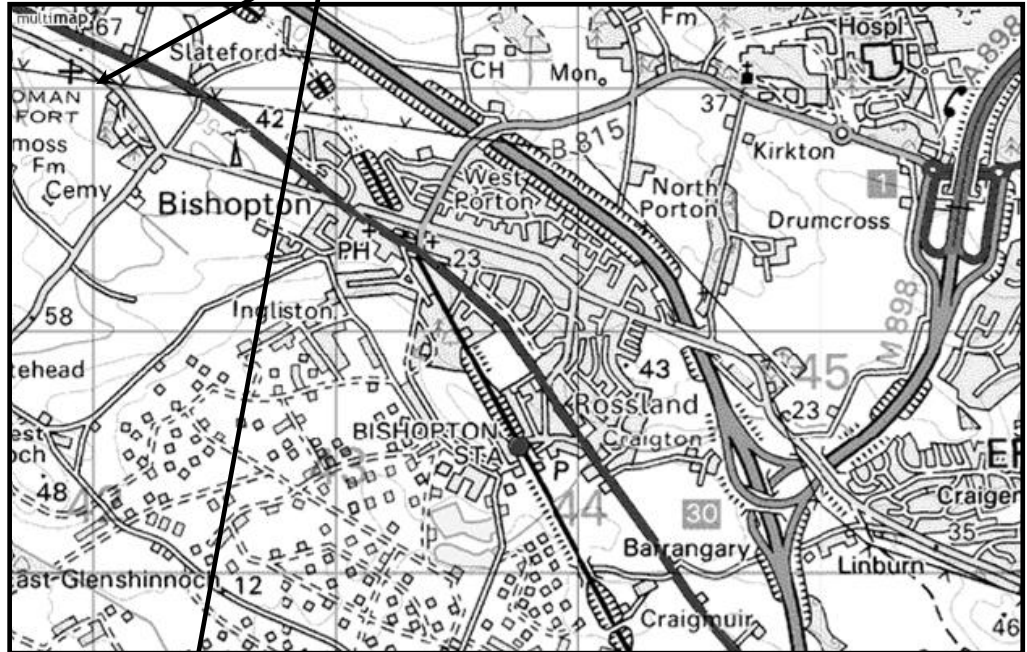

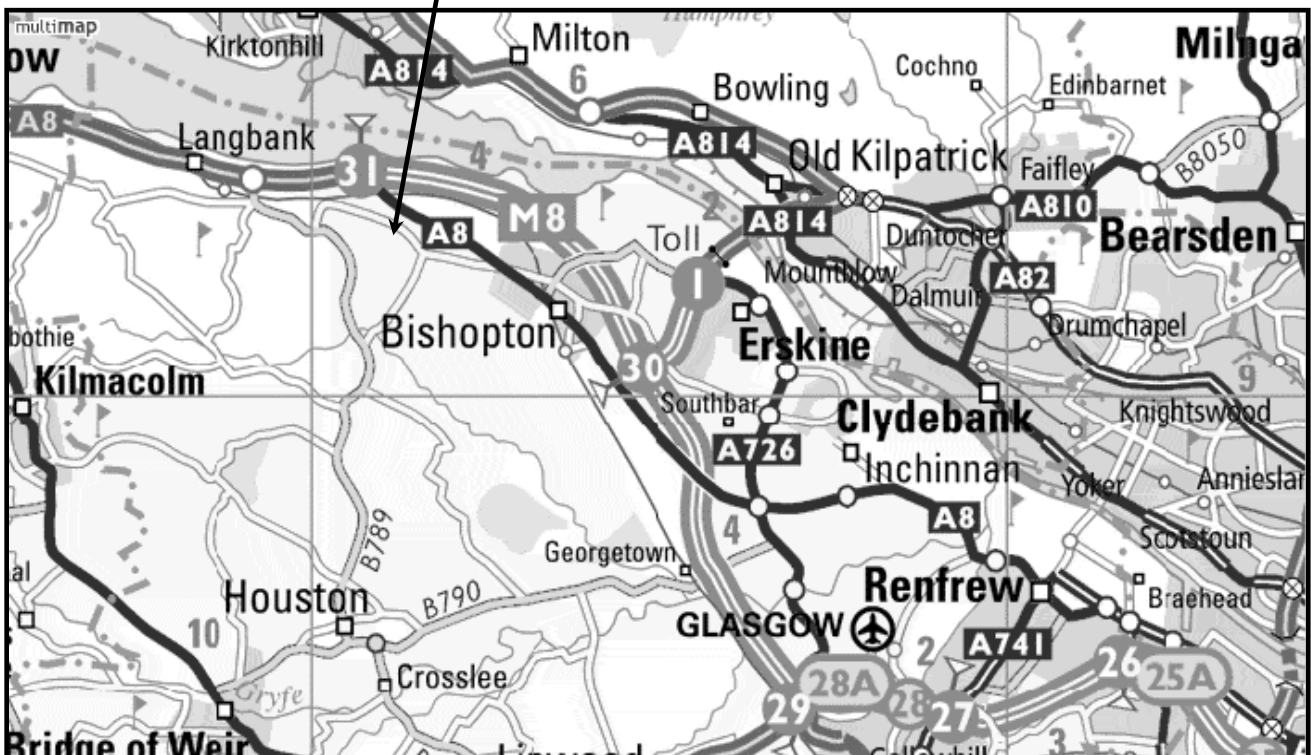
DIRECTIONS TO **Ingliston Country Club**

AFFILIATION RULES & NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure they are conversant with the rules of the relevant governing Society.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW, HICKSTEAD 27th to 31st July 2011

This Show is a qualifier for the Royal International Horse Show. The Ladies, Small, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Amateur and Working Hunter, Small & Large Hacks, Small & Large Riding Horses and Lightweight, Heavyweight & Maxi Cobs, and the BSPS Pretty Polly classes are qualifiers. See below for qualification criteria in each section.

SPORTS HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

This Show is affiliated to SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN and all Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's 2011 Rules.

- The Ladies, Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Working Hunter and Amateur Hunter classes (1,3,4,5,6,7,40) are qualifying events for this year's **Royal International Horse Show** (27th to 31st July 2011), and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Ladies, Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. The three highest placed horses in the Amateur Ridden and Working Hunter Hunter class will qualify.
- The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes are also qualifiers for **The National Hunter Supreme Championship Show** to be held at Addington Manor on 6th & 7th September 2011, with the 1st, 2nd & 3rd horses in each class qualifying for the final.
- Horses entered in Class 2, Novice Hunter must be registered on the Basic Identity Register, and not have won a first prize of £60 or a total of £200 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad, before 1st January in the current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old. Any horse that qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show in a Ridden Hunter Class (not including Working Hunter Classes) will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and for the RIHS qualifying classes, owners and riders must be members of the Society. The Society offers a Temporary Registration to competitors who wish to compete at up to THREE qualifying shows for a fee of £12 per show (*Horses need to be on the Basic Identity Register before they can be on the Show Register or have a Temporary Registration*). If the horse subsequently qualifies then they will need to complete their full registration before the Championship Show for which the horse has qualified and the £12 fee will be refunded.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

(formerly British Show Hack, Cob & Riding Horse Association)

This Show is affiliated to the BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION and the Hack, Riding Horse and Cob classes will be held under the Rules and jurisdiction of the British Show Horse Association.

- Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.
- Classes 11-17 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. In Maxi Cob qualifiers the first three will qualify.
- Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show.
- The three highest placed prize winners in all **Open** Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show on September 9th & 10th 2011.
- The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Championship rosette for each section.
- **DAY TICKETS** Non-members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per exhibitor, per horse per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Novice classes only, but will not allow entry into RIHS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can purchase a Day Ticket from the BSHA office.
- The Rising Stars Championships 2011. Any Exhibitor placed in the first 3 in Intermediate classes for Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type may enter the Rising Stars class at the BSHA National Championship Show September 9th & 10th 2011 at Addington. No qualifying card required.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS (Affiliation No: 2749S/2011) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

- This Show is a qualifier for the 2011 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK, Grantham on 24th to 27th August 2011. The 1st and 2nd prizewinners only in Classes 18,19,24-27, 38, 42-44 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in Classes 21,28,37,41, 57 & 58 and the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners in Classes 20, 39 & 60 will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 23. Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the championship they qualify for.

- **ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW** This show is a qualifier for the Royal International Horse Show. Only one pony in each of the Pretty Polly Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony, Pretty Polly 133cm SHP & the Pretty Polly Mixed Height SHP will qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first three ponies in each class will qualify.
- **PRETTY POLLY CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL** This show is a qualifier for the NEW 'Dalton Stud' Supreme Pretty Polly Ridden Championship Final, to be held at the North of England Summer Pony Show on 16th July 2011. The Champion from classes 29 to 33 will qualify, if the Champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion will qualify. Prize money at the Final: 1st; £1000, 2nd; £400, 3rd; £100, 4th; £50, 5th; £25, 6th; £25, 7th; £25, 8th; £25
- **BSPS CHALLENGE** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, the highest placed pony in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open WHP, Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH and the Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes that has not qualified for the 2011 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the CHALLENGE.
- **BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE** This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify in the Open Lead Rein & First Ridden Show Ponies, the Open Ridden Show Pony, the Lead Rein of Hunter Type, the Open Show Hunter Ponies, the Intermediate SRT & SH, the Cradle & Nursery Stakes, the Open Working Hunter Ponies, Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden, Open Heritage WHP classes.
- **BSPS CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Open Show Pony (if the class is split), Champion Intermediate, Champion Mini WHP, the Champion SHP, the Champion Open WHP/WH, the Champion Mini Heritage and the Winners of the Open Mixed Breed Ridden Heritage & Mixed Height Open WHP Heritage classes will qualify.
- **BSPS BEST RIDER** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Mixed Height Show Pony, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open First Ridden Hunter Pony, Open 122cm, 133cm, 143cm & 153cm SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms

WHP, the Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Open Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show.

TULLIBARDINE WORKING HUNTER PONY FINALS

This show is a qualifying round for the Blair Castle Tullibardine Contractors Working Hunter Pony Series: Ponies placed first to fourth in the qualifying classes (classes 41 to 44) will qualify for the Championships held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 18th August 2011. Qualification may go down to sixth place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified. *Please note the change to the rules, in that ponies no longer need to have jumped a clear round.*

NPS SCOTLAND QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifying round for the NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Ridden M&M Championship (the 2 Highest placed **eligible** ponies not already qualified from Class 59 will qualify), NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden M&M Championship (the 2 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from Class 60 will qualify) and the NPS Scotland/Kingfisher Building Products M&M WHP Championship (the 3 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from Class 36 will qualify) to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 19th August 2011. The rules for these competitions are as follows:

1. Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred and X registered ponies and Eriskays are not eligible.
3. Qualification to go no lower than 6th place.
4. For Novice classes. Ponies must wear a snaffle bridle & must not have won a 1st in an open ridden mixed M. & M. or breed class prior to Jan 1st 2011. An open class is one for Registered Ponies that does not mention Junior, Novice, Intermediate, Lead Rein or 1st Ridden in its description. *(as these classes are judged under BSPS rules, the highest placed unqualified may not be eligible under NPS rules, so the qualification will go down the line as far as the first eligible pony, but not beyond 6th place)*
5. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card, duly signed by the judge at the time of qualifying, with your entry form.
6. The **OWNER** must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
7. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.(selected Shows only)
8. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 19th August 2011.

(Should any of the above classes be split on the day, only one pony from each section will qualify, in the case of the Ridden classes, should they be split to more than 2 classes then a championship will be held and the Champion & Reserve will qualify)

CHAPS(UK) CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

This Show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both the owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse/pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both Showing Members and the horse/pony be registered with the society BEFORE this Show for the qualification to be valid. Membership Cards and Qualification Cards must be produced in the ring and the latter signed by the judge in two places. These classes are also qualifiers for the Ponies (UK) Summer Championships, please refer to your CHAPS (UK) Members Handbook or www.chapsuk.com for full details.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 2nd 3rd & 4th September 2011. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies (UK) Summer Championships will be held on 10th-13th August 2011.

The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers (Classes 52 -56). For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. **All Stallions entering these classes must be graded or valid First Stage Approved with CHAPS(UK) and must display their CHAPS (UK) Bridle Disc.**

EX-RACERS CLUB SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the above Championship to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Sunday 21st August 2011. All horses must be registered with the Ex Racers Club. Registration (once in a lifetime fee of £10) forms can be found at www.exracersclub.com. In classes 47 & 48 all horses placed 1st to 4th will qualify for the Scottish Ex Racers Club Champion of Champions classes at Blair Castle Horse Trials.

THE TATTERSALLS & RoR THOROUGHBRED RIDDENSHOW HORSE CLASS – FINAL AT RHS 2012

Class 45: Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle. Horses should be plaited. The first three go forward to the championship at the Royal Highland Show 2012. Qualification will go down to 6th place if the first 3 have already

qualified. All entries **MUST** be registered with Weatherbys in their General Stud Book. and **MUST** also be registered with the ROR. The class is open to thoroughbreds that have **RACED**. There will be a prize for the highest placed veteran 15years or over. The class will be run under the rules of RoR. Horses to be ridden by the judge. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.**

BLAIR CASTLE RIDDEN CLYDESDALE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Class 46 is a qualifier for the Blair Castle Ridden Clydesdale Championships to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Sunday 21st August 2011. The first two will qualify, and the qualification can go down to 4th place if the horses placed 1st and 2nd have previously qualified.

NOVICE DEFINITIONS

- BSPS:** A Pony of six years old and over that has three BSPS Affiliated Open or Restricted Open or Pretty Polly Open wins where there is a first prize of £5 or over or placed 1st – 5th at RIHS or HOYS in a particular class is no longer eligible for Novice in that particular class for the remainder of its career.
- NPS:** A novice pony is one that has not won a 1st place in either an Open Mixed Mountain & Moorland or breed ridden class prior to 1st January 2010 (those not eligible under NPS Rules, may still compete in the BSPS Novice Heritage class, but may not qualify for the NPS Novice Finals at Blair Castle)
- SHB(GB):** Novice Hunter must not have won a first prize of £60 or a total of £200 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad, before 1st January in the current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old.
- BSHA:** A Novice is a Hack, Cob or Riding Horse that has not won a first prize of £25 or more, or more than a total of £100 in showing classes, excluding Working Cobs, working Riding Horse, Best Trained, Pairs or Side Saddle classes that were affiliated to the Association at home or abroad, prior to 1st January 2011. Winnings as a four year old excepted unless that four year old has won an open class. Snaffles may be worn in novice classes. *(further detailed rules are available under Rule 7e, Page 10 of the 2010 Rule Book)*

Please see Rule Book for relevant Society for full details of each specific class

REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

HUNTERS: Owners & riders must be Member of SHB(GB) & horses must be on the 2011 Show Hunter Register or be in possession of a Day Ticket to compete in the Ladies, Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight & Working Hunter and Amateur Ridden Hunter classes (1,3-7, 40). Horses entered in the Novice Hunter (class 2) must be recorded on the Basic Identity Register (once in a lifetime registration). Neither Owner nor Rider are required to be a member of SHB(GB) to compete in the Novice Hunter class.

HACKS, COBS & RIDING HORSES: Owners and riders must be a Member of British Horse Association and horses must be registered for the current season to compete in the RIHS Hack, Riding Horse and Cob (incl Maxi Cobs) classes 11-17). Entries can be made for the Novice Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes (8,9,10) with either full registration/membership or on purchase of a Day Ticket at £15.

BSPS PRETTY POLLY: Owners and riders must be members of BSPS and ponies registered for the 2011 season to compete in these classes (classes 29 – 33)

EX-RACEHORSES: (classes 47 & 48) must be registered with Ex-Racers Club to enter and compete. This cost is a once in a lifetime fee of £10.

RETRAINED RACEHORSES: (class 45) must be registered with RoR to be eligible to compete. Details on their website: www.ror.org.uk

All other classes are open to all competitors and no annual membership/registration to any society is required to enter or compete. In all M&M classes all animals must be registered in their relevant Breed Society Stud Book.

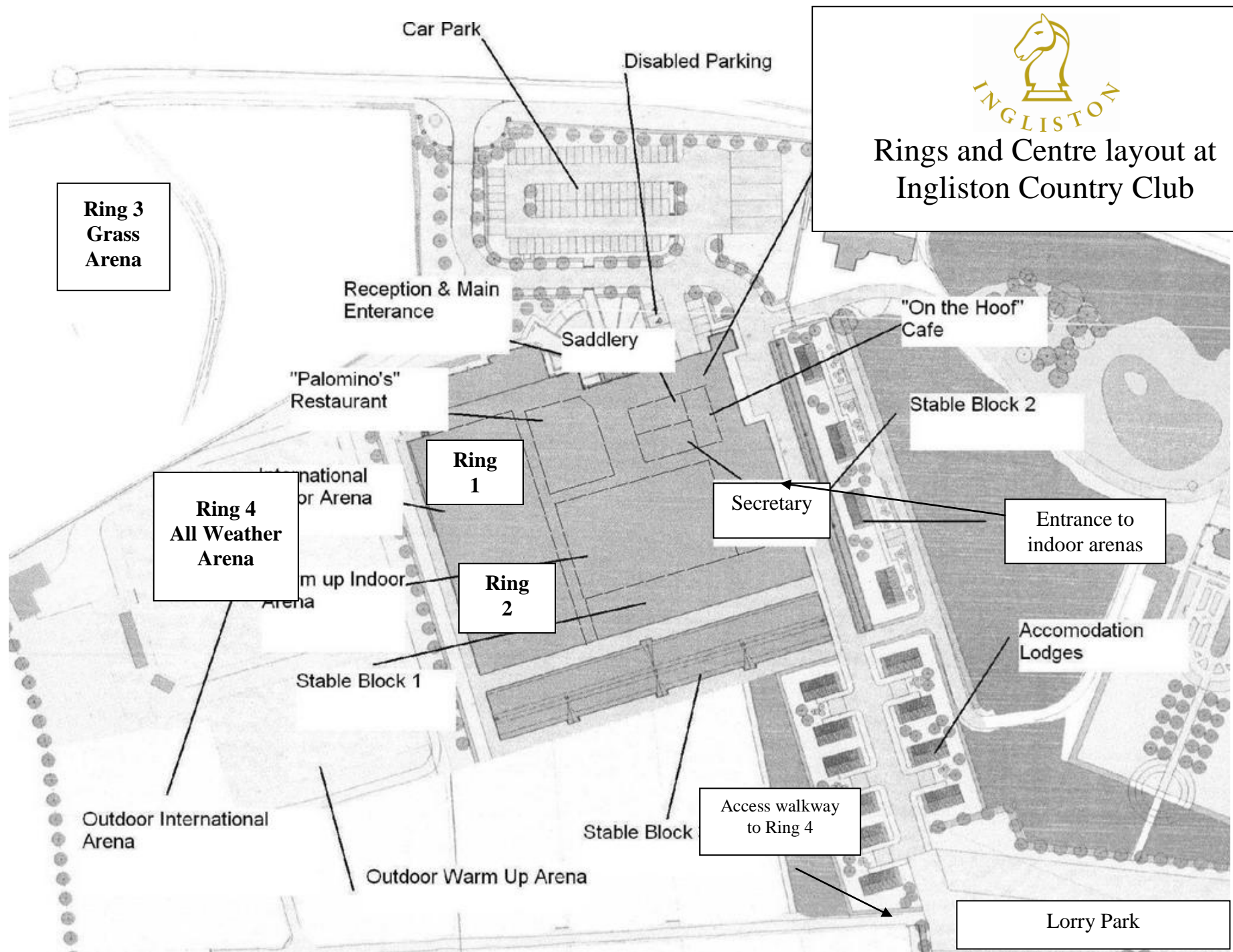
