

In the Event of Bad Weather

In view of the bad weather experienced for the early Puddledub Winter Shows in 2010 and the snow and ice in December we are aware of the vagaries of the Scottish weather but are also mindful of the need for Scottish competitors to qualify for the Winter Champs and to get young horses and ponies out for some ring experience. We will therefore endeavour to run our shows regardless of weather and make amendments to cope on the day.

However, as most entries are made on the day, and we can therefore not contact all, competitors should phone the secretary/organiser if they are in any doubt of any particular show going ahead.

The Sandyflat Show will run with one indoor ring for both jumping and individual show as the weather may mean the outdoor school may not be so congenial! However if the entries are higher than expected, and the weather permits, then a second judge could be brought in for all or some of the 'plaited' WHPs with the conformation & show done outside to speed things up.

The boring but essential small print and official bit

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS (No: 30595/11) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

All Rules as per the 2011 Rule & Show Handbook.

BSPS Winter Championship Qualification

The following Classes (4,5,6,8 & 9) are qualifiers for the BSPS Winter Championships Show. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners will qualify in the novice Classes and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners will qualify. In the Open Classes the three highest placed Open and the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Open and the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, **(riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)**. Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by BSPS Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate (ex Heritage Classes) before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

AGES FOR RIDERS OF STALLIONS. Riders must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed M & M stallions ie. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Riders must be 14 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed M & M stallions ie. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION

Any animal that has qualified for the Nursery Stakes/Working Hunter Pony/Intermediate WH classes at the RIHS or HOYS in 2010 or the current year or any M&M animal that has qualified for the M&M WHP classes at RIHS or HOYS in 2010 or the current year are not eligible for the Restricted qualification in classes of the same SECTION. **(Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)**.

TRAINING WORKING HUNTER CLASS

Here is an opportunity to jump the height of course of your choice regardless of winnings/status of your horse or pony. Help and advice will be available to anyone who may need it, or you are more than welcome to take your trainer in the ring. You may compete as many times as you would like.

FUN, WARM UP, PRACTICE, LEARN!!



Class 1 TRAINING CLASS, will start at 1'6" (or smaller if required) and go up in intervals, for any pony or horse, any height, plaited or natural. All those jumping a clear round will receive a rosette. Subject to time, a horse/pony can compete as many times as wished at each height. *(a further Training session will be held between the Pony & Horse classes if time permits)*

WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

Class 2 LEAD REIN WHP, mares or geldings , 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. No age limit for riders. This class is intended for novice/nervous riders not confident to attempt a course on their own. Pony/rider combinations entered in this class will not be eligible to compete in any other class (other than clear round/training class). Maximum height of fences 50cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers.

All riders who complete will receive a small prize in addition to rosettes

Class 3 BSPS OPEN CRADLE STAKES PONY, mares or geldings , 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

(Please note this class is NOT a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championships – as no qualification is required for this class)

Class 4 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES PONY, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *A Rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Novice Pony in this class. (Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)*

MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 3 & 4

Class 5 BSPS NOVICE MIXED HEIGHT WHP/WH, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of pony that they ride. (133cms/14yrs; 143cms/17yrs; 153cms/20yrs; 158cms/25yrs. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms must declare before the class commences whether they wish to compete in the 153cm or Intermediate section.

The 133cm ponies will jump first.

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries



Class 6 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) WHP/WH, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of pony that they ride. (133cms/14yrs; 143cms/17yrs; 153cms/20yrs; 158cms/25yrs. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms must declare before the class commences whether they wish to compete in the 153cm or Intermediate section. **The 158cm ponies will jump first.**

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries

(Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)



HERITAGE WHP CLASSES

Class 7 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NURSERY STAKES. Registered Pure-Bred Ponies 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *(Please note this class is **NOT** a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championships – as no qualification is required for this class)*

Class 8 BSPS NOVICE HERITAGE MIXED HEIGHT M&M WHP. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, Registered Pure Bred ponies. Riders any age. In a mixed height class, riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals must jump in their correct height section. **Small height will jump first.**
This class will be split if there are sufficient entries



Class 9 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) HERITAGE M&M MIXED HEIGHT WHP. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, Registered Pure Bred ponies. Riders any age. In a mixed height class, riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals must jump in their correct height section. **Large height will jump first. (Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)**

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries

M&M WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 7, 8 & 9

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

Not before 2.30pm

Class 10 Nursery Novice Working Hunter. Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences will not exceed 2'

Class 11 Novice Working Hunter. Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences will not exceed 2' 6"

Class 12 Open Working Hunter. Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences approx 3'3"

WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP – open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 10, 11 & 12

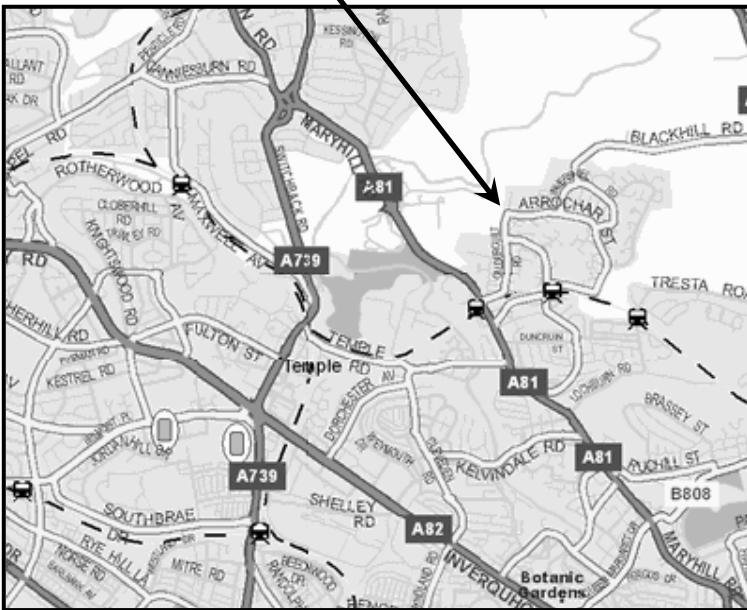

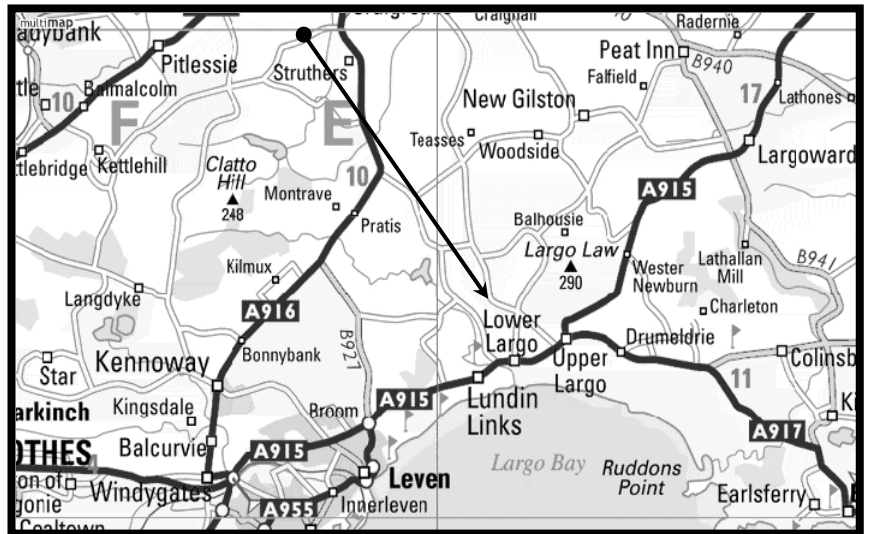
Exit the M8 from Junction 16 and follow the A81 through Maryhill. Turn onto Caldercuilt Road just before the start of a section of dual carriageway (opposite British rail sign). *(If you get to a large roundabout you have gone too far and need to turn around)* Follow Caldercuilt Road across a small roundabout. Sandyflat is straight ahead of you at the junction to Arrochar Street.

Balcormo KY8 5QF

Approach Balcormo on the A916 Windygates/Cupar road turning off at the road just north of Montrave & Pratis Farm. Then take the second left, turn right at T junction and then immediately left.

Balcormo is set on both sides of the road, so please be aware of traffic. Parking

is also on both sides of the road and is slightly limited – **SO PLEASE PARK AS CLOSE TO NEXT HORSEBOX AS POSSIBLE AND WITH CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS!**



There is no indoor warm-up or collecting ring at either Sandyflat or Balcormo, so please bring plenty of warm, waterproof clothing in case of poor weather.
