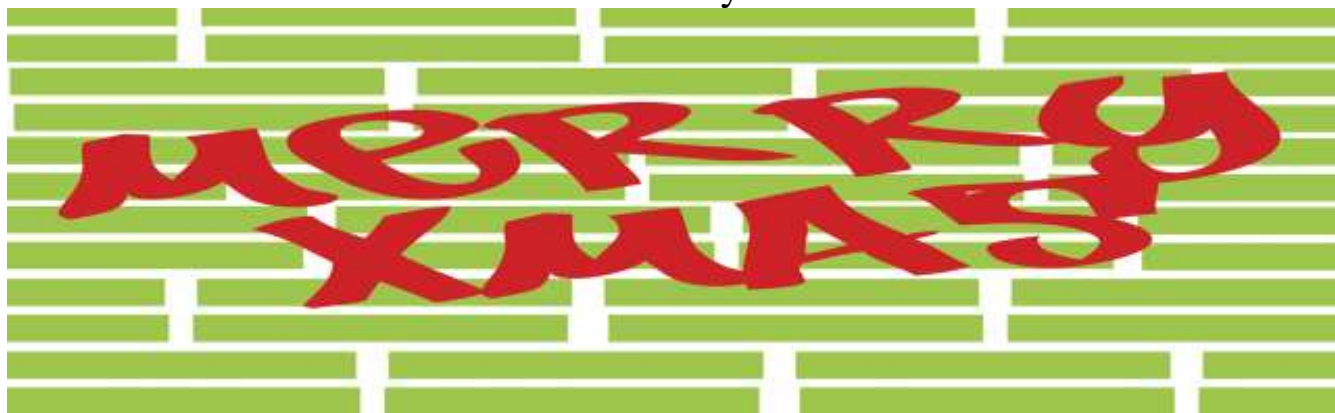

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This Show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2011.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2010/2011 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championship will not debar ponies from the NPS 2011 Mountain & Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

(If a show holds the Open Ridden, Novice Ridden and Pure Novice Ridden qualifiers two classes must be held for each qualifier, small and large breeds. If a show holds the In Hand qualifier either two or four classes can be held, either split by age or by breed size. Competitions may be split into more than the suggested number of classes at the discretion of the show – additional qualification cards will be supplied for all classes)

ALL RIDDEN CLASSES EXCEPT LEAD REIN WILL ALSO BE A QUALIFIER FOR THE NPS/AREA25/THE UNDERWOOD FAMILY YOUNG RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP (for riders under the age of 25)

Classes 1-4 qualify for the NPS/LEYHILLS M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Classes 1-4 Handlers any age, except for stallions and colts where the handler must be 14 years of age or older

1. Small Breeds. Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding. Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Books.
2. Small Breeds. 4 years and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Books.
3. Large Breeds. Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding. Registered in the main body of their respective Breeds Society Stud Books.
4. Large Breeds. 4 years and over. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Books.

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1-4)

Class 5 qualifies for the NPS/T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

5. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A & B Mare and Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not to have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

Class 6 qualifies for the NPS/KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

6. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A & B Mare and Gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Registered in the main body of their respective Bred Society Stud Book. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 5-6)

Classes 7-8 qualify for the NPS/FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

7. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Stallion Mare and Gelding, 4 years old and over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current

Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

8. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland New Forest, Welsh C & D Stallion, Mare and Gelding, 4 years old and over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS rules).

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 7-8)

Classes 9-10 qualify for the NPS/SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

9. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland Welsh A & B Stallion, Mare and Gelding 4 years old and over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS rules).
10. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D Stallion, Mare and Gelding 4 years old and over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS rules)

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 9-10)

BSPS Winter Championship

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society affiliation number 3058S/10, and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

The following classes are (11,12,16-22) are qualifiers for the B.S.P.S Winter Championship Show. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners will qualify in the Novice Classes and Open First Pony of Show Hunter Type. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize winners in the Open section and the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify for the Restricted section. In the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners will qualify. In the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN (RESTRICTED) CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners will qualify for the Open section and the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Restricted animals may also be placed in the overall class and qualify for both the Open and Restricted sections.

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid J.M.B Certificate (ex Heritage) before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

Show held on or before 31st December 2010 – All Rules as per the 2010 B.S.P.S Rule & Show Handbook, except for any new or amended rules as included in this Schedule.

Show held on or after 1st January 2011 – All Rules as per the 2011 B.S.P.S Rule & Show Handbook, All ponies must be four years old and over. Ages for riders as per the B.S.P.S Rule & Show Handbook.

Rules for Restricted Classes – Any animal that has qualified for the open classes at the R.I.H.S or H.O.Y.S in the previous or current year is not eligible for the Restricted qualification in the open classes.

11. The BSPPS “Heritage” Mountain & Moorland Novice Ridden Mixed Breeds. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.
12. The BSPPS “Heritage” Mountain & Moorland Open (Restricted) Ridden Mixed Breeds. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 11-12)

13. BSPPS Leading Rein Show Pony, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (not a qualifier)
14. BSPPS First Ridden Show Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (not a qualifier)
15. BSPPS Lead Rein Pony of Hunter Type, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. (not a qualifier)
16. BSPPS First Pony of Show Hunter Type, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring at the walk or trot.

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 13-16)

17. BSPPS Mixed Height Class for Novice Show Ponies, not exceeding 148cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

18. BSPS Mixed Height Class for Open (Restricted) Show Ponies, not exceeding 148cms. Competitor must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.
19. BSPS Mixed Height Class for Novice Show Hunter Pony, not exceeding 153cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of pony they ride.
20. BSPS Mixed Height Class for Open (Restricted) Show Hunter Pony, not exceeding 153cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of pony they ride.
21. BSPS Mixed Novice Intermediate Show Riding Type/Show Hunter, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
22. BSPS Mixed Open (Restricted) Intermediate Show Riding Type/Show Hunter, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 17-22)

Chaps (UK) Winter Restricted Qualifiers

Both the owner not the rider of any exhibit need not be fully paid-up members of Chaps (UK) at the time of competition, nor must the animal be registered; but to validate the qualification, both membership and registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualification. Send to Chaps (UK) Admin, 1 McLaren Cottages, Abertyswg, Rhymney, Tredegar, NP22 5BH. All stallions MUST BE graded with Chaps (UK) in order to compete in these classes. Exhibits not to have qualified for HOYS in the current and previous year in which the Finals will be held (e.g for 2011 Finals the horse or pony must not have qualified for HOYS in either 2009 or 2010).

From the class four animals may qualify from the class placings:-

Non-Native Horse (exceeding 15hh) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to be ridden by the judge at the Final.

Non-Native Pony (15hh and under) to be shown plaited and trimmed and to perform an individual show at the Final.

Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob Type Horse (exceeding 14.2hh) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to be ridden by the judge at the Final.

Native/Traditional/Cob/Show Cob Type Pony (14.2hh and under) to be shown either with full mane, tail and feathers or hogged and trimmed as appropriate, to perform an individual show at the Final.

23. Chaps Restricted Qualifier, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.
24. Riding Horse, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Rider any age.
25. Hunter, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 15hh. Riders any age.
26. Cob, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. To be shown hogged and trimmed.
27. Coloured Horse/Pony, 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age.
28. Pure, Anglo and Part Bred Arab, 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age.
29. Part Bred Mountain & Moorland, 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 23-29)

30. Mountain & Moorland Foal
31. Pony Foal, not to exceed 148cms at maturity.
32. Horse Foal, to exceed 148cms at maturity.
33. Mountain & Moorland 3 years & under.
34. Pony 3 years & under, not to exceed 148cms at maturity.
35. Horse 3 years & under, to exceed 148cms at maturity.
36. Mountain & Moorland, 4 years & over.
37. Pony, 4 years & over, not exceeding 148cms.
38. Horse, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms.
39. Coloured, any age, any height.
40. Part Bred, any age, any height.

IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 30-40)

RULES & REGULATIONS

- The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes.
- Correctly secured Riding Hats/Skull Caps which are approved by BSI standards MUST be worn when mounted.
- Stallions/Colts may not be led by any Junior who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- The JUDGES decision is final.
- No competitor shall enter under a Judge who has owned, sold or received financial gain from that pony.
- The committee or any of its assistants are in no way responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants, nor any member of the public or to any animal, vehicle brought onto the showground.
- Objections must be made in writing within ½ hr to the secretary. The sum will be returned if the objection is sustained.
- Foul language or abusive behaviour will NOT be tolerated towards other people or animals and will be asked to leave the Showground.
- Acceptance of the foregoing will be condition of entry.
