AFFILIATION RULES & NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure they are conversant with the rules of the relevant governing Society. Please see Rule Books for full details of each specific class.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW, HICKSTEAD

This Show is a qualifier for the Royal International Horse Show on the 26th July – 31st July 2011. The Small, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Amateur, Ladies Hunter and Working Hunter are qualifiers.

SPORTS HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

This Show is affiliated to SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN and all Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's Rules.

- The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Ladies Hunter, Working Hunter and Amateur Hunter classes are qualifying events for this year's **Royal International Horse Show** (26th July – 31st July 2011), and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. The three highest placed horses in the Amateur Ridden and Working Hunter class will qualify.
- The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes are also qualifiers for **The National Hunter Supreme Championship Show** to be held at Addington Manor on 6th & 7th September 2011, with the 1st, 2nd & 3rd horses in each class qualifying for the final.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society. The Society offers a Temporary Registration to competitors who wish to compete at THREE qualifying show for a fee of £12 per show (*Horses need to be on the Basic Identity Register before they can be on the Show Register or have a Temporary Registration*). If the horse subsequently qualifies then they will need to complete their full registration before the Championship Show for which the horse has qualified and £12 fee will be refunded.

REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

HUNTERS: Owners & riders must be Member of SHB (GB) & horses must be on the 2011 Show Hunter Register or be in possession of a Day Ticket to compete in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Ladies Hunter, Working Hunter and Amateur Ridden Hunter classes.

STEWARTS BUILDING SERVICES/BHS SCOTLAND WORKING HUNTER SERIES 2011

To be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Game Fair on Thursday 19th August 2011. Eight to twelve fences approximately 3'6" in height, judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding of GB Rules, (Show Regulations on www.sporhorsegb.co.uk). The 1st three prize winners will qualify for the final. If one of these have already qualified the fourth placed horse can qualify provided they have a clear round in the jumping phase. To be eligible for the final either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the British Horse Society. The 1st three placed horse will be given a postcard to fill in and send off with their entry fee for the final. Cards to be sent to Blair Castle Horse Trials Office.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors and Horses need to be registered or have temporary membership with a day ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be owned, exhibited and ridden by current BSHA members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

Horses competing in the Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show.

DAYTICKETS

Non-members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per exhibitor, per horse per season. A day ticket will allow entry into Novice, Amateur, Young Rider, Home Produced, Working and Open affiliated classes only but will not allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a day ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can purchase a day ticket from the BSHA office.

The three highest placed prize winners in all **OPEN** affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show on 9th & 10th September 2011.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each open class and a Championship rosette for each section.

INTERMEDIATE CLASSES - RISING STARS

Any exhibitor placed in the first 3 in Intermediate classes for Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type may enter the Rising Stars class at the BSHA National Championship Show, September 9th & 10th 2011 at Addington. No qualifying card required.

THE BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE

The Show is a Qualifier for the **BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE**. The highest placed horse from Classes 59,60,61,76,77,78,79,82,83,85,86 that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, i.e. **with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding**. Horses need not be registered to qualify but must be on the IDHS(GB) registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show (date & venue to be announced) will qualify for the final of the Blue Chip & IDHS(GB) Championship. **NB: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.** Each qualifier will receive a rosette and £10 voucher

from Blue Chip. **Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhs.gb.com to inform the IDHS(GB) that they have qualified for the final. Following submission of the online form, a qualifiers pack will be sent out, including the £10 Blue Chip Feeds voucher.** In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Trophy and Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. Also the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will be awarded a Trophy and £100 and the highest placed 15.2hh and under will receive a Trophy and £50.

IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB)

The Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) will award Special Incentive Rosettes to the highest placed pure bred Irish Draught Horse or Irish Draught Sport Horse in the following classes 59,60,61,76,77,78,79,82,83,85,86. All exhibits must be registered or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) on either their Irish Draught Horse Society Breed Register or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY

This Show is a qualifier for The NPS Summer Championship Show on 3-5 August 2011. Classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Standard members will be required to upgrade to Full membership to enter the Final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

A Silver Medal Rosette - These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded where the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider/handlers possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or steward. If the owner of the champion pony is not a member or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the reserve champion provided they have the required membership card. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the reserve champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosettes and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championship. A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the NPS for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Kilmannan Stud M & M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern or at the Championship Show in Scotland. You may only compete in one Kilmannan Final.

Area 25 Home Produced In Hand - These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. Ponies shown in these classes must be produced and shown by the owner/spouse or his/her immediate family, who does not deprive income from working with ponies or horse. **Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.**

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY

This Show is affiliated to the **British Show Pony Society (BSPS)**, and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. The final will be held at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show qualifies for the **BSPS Challenge** the highest placed pony in the Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Leading Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony, Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH that has not qualified for the 2011 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying for the BSPS Challenge a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

This Show is a qualifier for the **BSPS Best Rider of the Year**. The Best Rider in the Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms, 148cms Open Show Pony, The Lead Rein of Hunter Type, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms, 153cms Open SHP, Nursery Stakes, the Open 133cms, 143cms, 153cms WHP, Cradle Stakes, Inter SRT, SH and WH classes will receive a card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the **BSPS 2011 Championship Show** to be held at Arena UK. The 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 26,27,29,30,31,43,44,45,46,48,51,52,53, and 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize winners from classes 32,33,47,50 and 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th prize winners from classes 28,42,49 will qualify for the Championship Show provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 23 & 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

This Show is a qualifier for the **BSPS Premier League** the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th placed ponies in the Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms, 148cms Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cms, 153cms SHP, Nursery Stakes, 133cms, 143cms, 153cms, Cradle Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SRT, SH and WH classes

This Show is a qualifier for **BSPS Champion of Champions**, the Champion Mini Show Pony, Champion Open Show Pony, Champion Open Show Hunter Pony, Champion Open Intermediate, Champion, Champion Cradle Stakes, Champion Open WHP/WH will qualify.

PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK)

This show is affiliated to Ponies Association (UK). The 1st, 2nd, & 3rd placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships classes 6,7,8,9,17,18,19,20,21,26,27,28,29,30,31,32,33,40,42,43,44,45,46,48,51,52,53,72,73,76,77,78,79,80,81,82,83,84,85 & 86 will qualify for the 2011 P(UK) Summer National Championships. Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) office within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows held between 1st July & 31st July; these shows need to submit their results within 48 hours after the qualifying show. Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring. Competitors in qualifying position, who are not current members of P(UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horse/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1st July & 31st July their membership must be submitted within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid. Please see Rule Book if eligible for Pollyanna Confined Novice/Pollyanna Home Produced/Pollyanna Amateur Rider qualifiers.

This Show is affiliated to **The Coloured Horse and Pony Society (UK)**. Both the owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. These classes are also qualifiers for Ponies (UK) Summer Championship, Please refer to your CHAPS Handbook.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 2-4 September 2011. Shows held on or after date of Championship will count as 2012 qualifiers. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies (UK) Summer Championship will be held on 10-13 August 2011.

SPORTS HORSE

This Show is a qualifying round for the Scottish Sports Horse Mare & Youngstock Championship to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 25th August 2011. These classes are aimed at identifying potential competition horses suitable for any or all three Olympic disciplines: dressage, show jumping or eventing. The two highest placed animals in each class will receive a qualifying rosette and card signed by the judge in the ring, qualification can be passed down the line but no lower than 4th place. The Scottish Sports Horse will also award a special rosette to the highest placed Brood Mare, Foal, Yearling, 2yr and 3yr passported with SSH in each class. Horses need not be passported or over-stamped not handlers members of the SSH in order to enter the qualifying classes, however qualifying exhibitors MUST be fully paid up members and horses MUST be registered with SSH prior to the closing date of the Championship Show.
