RULES

- ❖ A points form should be completed for each pony for each class
- ❖ Only two Show results count each month ie your two highest placings
- ❖ The months of August/September are combined
- ❖ Double Points will be allocated in all **HOYS Qualifying classes, RIHS Qualifying classes**, and all BSPS classes at the **Scottish Championship Show** in June and the **Finale Show** in September. As there are no Cradle Stakes at RIHS or Cradle & Nursery Stakes at HOYS, double points will be awarded in these classes at shows where the WHP classes are RIHS or HOYS qualifiers.
- ❖ The Double Point Shows are in **addition** to the two show rule. New for 2010 this June includes the Royal Highland Show as well as Strathallan.
- ❖ The Heritage RIHS Qualifier classes at Rowallan A.C. will be eligible for double points. (No other classes at the Winter Shows will gain points).
- ❖ Points will only be allocated to registered ponies from the date of registration (as on your pony's registration card from Sawtry), no results prior to this registration date will be included
- ❖ A 'Best Home Produced Award' will be made to the best Home Produced (as defined in the Pretty Polly rules) in each section. Points are not awarded in 'Home Produced' classes, only Points gained for full listing will be considered for the 'Best Home Produced Award'
- ❖ The Highland Points Medal will be awarded to the member, residing in the Highland Region, with the highest number of points, in any one class, gained at affiliated shows in Scotland. It is not for an accumulation of points.
- ❖ Points are not awarded in home produced, pairs, coloured or veteran classes.
- ❖ Only points gained in Open classes can be counted for Open classes, Novice points for Novice classes etc
- ❖ Mixed height classes will be allocated points as one class
- ❖ Any pony/rider/owner subject to any disciplinary action from BSPS Head Office will not be eligible for points during such time
- ❖ Results sheets should be emailed to scottishbsps@aol.co.uk by 30th September 2010. Any emails received after that date will be included in the results but no discussion will be entered into on any discrepancy on points allocated – our calculations will be final.
- ❖ Trophies and Rosettes will be awarded at the Dinner Dance in November 2010 (All trophies to be signed for)
