RULES & REGULATIONS 15th May 2010

1. **All stabling & entries must be in no later than Friday 30th April 2010.**
2. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
3. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
4. The show organisers reserve the right to alter the order or timing of classes, or cancel any class, or event as may be considered necessary.
5. All dogs **MUST** be kept on a lead at all times within the premises.
6. No motorcycles or ball games are permitted in the premises.
7. Personal cheques will not be accepted. Cash or credit/debit cards only.
8. Entries received without the appropriate fee **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
9. Practice fences will be flagged and must be jumped in the correct direction.
10. The judges' decision is final.
11. All horses & ponies must be 4yrs old & over.
12. Competitors must wear correct clothing & tack in accordance to BSJA rules.
13. Lunging is not permitted in any working area.
14. Objections must be raised in writing to the Show Organisers within 30 minutes of any incident together with a deposit of £100. The deposit will be repaid if the objection is sustained.
15. The Organisers will not accept any legal liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, riders, spectators or any property owned by them. It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to indemnify the Organisers against any legal action that may arise from any cause whatsoever connected with the event.
16. Every competitor from the Girls Schools Association **MUST** wear a red armband.
17. Hard hats **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted and in the Young Handlers classes.
18. The event will run strictly in accordance with BSJA Rules.
19. All classes are pre-entry and will have a drawn order.
20. Children under 16yrs must be accompanied by an adult.
21. No assistance will be allowed when competing in the arenas.
22. Excessive use of spurs/whips or other maltreatment anywhere in the show ground will not be tolerated. Offenders may have their entries cancelled and fees may be forfeited.
23. Rosettes to 6th Place in every class.
24. No horse may be ridden by 2 different riders in the same class.
25. Competitors **MUST** wear either their school tie and/or a numnah with the school name.
26. All competitors **MUST** be in full time education.
27. All entry forms must be signed by the schools Chef D'Equipe and Head Teacher.
28. The submission of every entry will be deemed to include acceptance of these conditions.

SHOWJUMPING
Sat 15th May – Indoor Main Arena

**** HUNTLY/GLAMIS ARENA ****

Start 9am Prompt – All classes are pre-entry & drawn order

- Class 1** **Ingliston Novice Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
For competitors 12 & under. Fences 60cms in the first round. Competitors in this class may not jump in class 2 & 3 & must not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any other SJ competition. If competitors get clear in the 1st round they go through to the jump-off which will not exceed 70cms. 3 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)
- Class 2** **Ingliston Intermediate Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
For competitors 15 & under. Fences 70cms in the first round. If competitors get clear in the 1st round they go through to the jump-off which will not exceed 80cms. 3 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)
- Class 3** **Ingliston Open Class** **DRAWN ORDER**
For competitors 16 & over. Fences 80cms in the first round. If competitors get clear in the 1st round they go through to the jump-off which will not exceed 90cms. 3 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)
- Class 4** **** Ingliston & Craigholme Team Challenge for the Craigholme Trophy! ****
DRAWN ORDER
Open to all competitors of any age. Fences 70cms in the first round. Teams of 3 or 4 jump the 1st round, best 3 scores to count go forward to the jump-off which will not exceed 80cms. The team with the least faults & the fastest time wins! Trophy presented on the day. 3 stops will result in elimination.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 5 **Intro A (2008) 20x40m**

Open to all competitors of any age. To be run under British Dressage rules 2010.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 6 **Prelim 10 (2002) 20x40m**

Open to all competitors of any age. To be run under British Dressage rules 2010.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 7 **** Style & Performance with Music 148cms & Under ****

Open to all competitors of any age. The freestyle Performance show must include the following:
Halt/walk on a long rein/ordinary trot serpentine (2 or 3 loop serpentine acceptable)
Extended trot on the diagonal/ canter serpentine with simple change of lead/ extended canter on
the diagonal. Show must not exceed 2 minutes. Marking as follows.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

50 marks – Performance

50 marks – Music

Class 8 **** Style & Performance with Music 148cms & Over ****

Open to all competitors of any age. The freestyle Performance show must include the following:
Halt/walk on a long rein/ordinary trot serpentine (2 or 3 loop serpentine acceptable)
Extended trot on the diagonal/ canter serpentine with simple change of lead/ extended canter on
the diagonal. Show must not exceed 2 minutes. Marking as follows.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

50 marks – Performance

50 marks – Music

Method of Judging

This class is to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly. Marks are awarded to well trained horses and ponies performing correctly ridden movements in a freestyle manner in an area no larger than 40x60m.

In the event of a tie, the marks from the performance will take precedence. If there is still a tie the judges' decision in final.

Classes 5 – 8 will run in numerical order

MINI EVENT

**** TANTALLON ARENA ****

- Class 9 Novice Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or Gelding of any height. Rider not to have attained 12th Birthday from date of event. Max height of fences 2'0 /61cms.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)
- Class 10 Intermediate Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or Gelding of any height. Rider not to have attained 15th Birthday from date of event. Max height of fences 2'5 /76cms.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)
- Class 11 Open Mini Event DRAWN ORDER**
Mare or Gelding of any height. Rider over 15yrs. Max height of fences 3'1 /92cms.
Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Riders may only compete in one section and may only ride one horse/pony.

PHASE 1	Dressage Test – Class 5	70 Marks
PHASE 2	Showjumping	100 Marks
PHASE 3	Conformation, type & suitability for Eventing	30 Marks

Method of Judging

Horses/ponies come into the ring individually and complete phase 1 – the Dressage Test – then proceed immediately into phase 2 – the Jumping phase, then to phase 3 – conformation.

There are no set penalties for a pole down or a stop – but 3 stops will result in elimination.

Each jumping effort is marked out of 10.

All horses/ponies, unless eliminated, are required to come back without saddles for phase 3.

The judge does not have to sit at any appointed place for the Dressage Test, but may sit at a point they feel most appropriate – according to the design and layout of the arena.

RULES FOR THE MINI EVENT

Fall of horse or Pony anywhere on the course will result in elimination. Boots are permissible in Phases 1 & 2. In the event of a tie, the marks from Phase 2 will take precedence.

**** CULZEAN ARENA ****

All Young Handler classes are judged on the handlers' presentation and showing technique.

Start 9am Prompt – All classes are pre-entry.

Class 12 **Best Turned Out Horse or Pony**

Open to all competitors of any age. May be In hand or ridden class may be split dependent on entries.

Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 13 **Family Horse or Pony**

Open to all competitors of any age. To be shown under saddle. Snaffle bridles must be worn.

Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 14 **Young Handlers aged under 12yrs**

To be shown in hand. Class may be split depending on entries forward.

Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 15 **Young Handlers aged under 15yrs**

To be shown in hand. Class may be split depending on entries forward.

Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

Class 16 **Young Handlers aged over 16yrs**

To be shown in hand. Class may be split depending on entries forward.

Entry fee: £12 (incl medical)

All Showing classes will be run in numerical order.

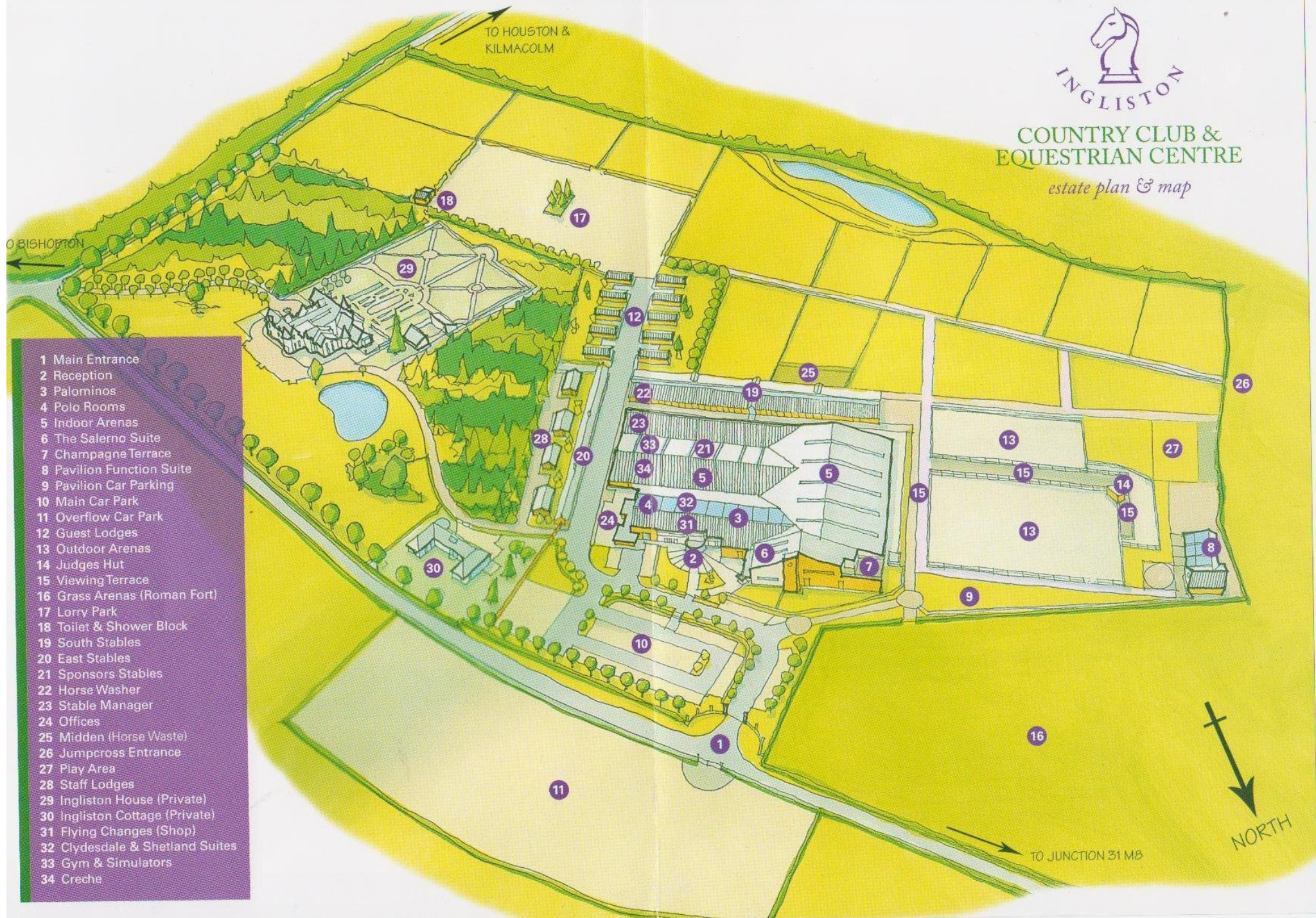
