IN HAND SPORTS HORSES & PONIES
JUDGE: MR R TELFORD, AYTON

This Show is a qualifying round for the Scottish Sports Horse Mare & Youngstock Championship to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 25th August 2011. These classes are aimed at identifying potential competition horses suitable for any or all three Olympic disciplines: dressage, show jumping or eventing. The two highest placed animals in each class will receive a qualifying rosette and card signed by the judge in the ring, qualification can be passed down the line but no lower than 4th place. The Scottish Sports Horse will also award a special rosette to the highest placed Brood Mare, Foal, Yearling, 2yr and 3yr passported with SSH in each class. Horses need not be passported or over-stamped not handlers members of the SSH in order to enter the qualifying classes, however qualifying exhibitors MUST be fully paid up members and horses MUST be registered with SSH prior to the closing date of the Championship Show.

Classes 17-21 are qualifiers for CHAPS (UK) Sport Horse/Pony Coloured classes at CHAPS (UK) Championship Show on 2-4th September 2011. The highest placed Coloured CHAPS (UK) Member/Registered exhibit may qualify should they have their qualifier card signed in the ring.

- 1 Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
- 2 All Mountain & Moorland ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part Breds and X registered ponies and Eriskays are not eligible.
- 3 Qualification in the M & M In Hand section may go to 3rd in the Championship. Lead Rein & First Ridden classes no lower than 8th place. M&M Open, Novice WHP and RP/NP no lower than 6th place.
- 4 For the Novice class – Ponies must wear a snaffle bridle & must not have won a 1st in any Open Ridden Mixed M & M or breed class prior to 1st January 2011. An Open class is one for registered ponies that does not mention, Junior, Novice, Intermediate, Lead Rein or First Ridden in its description. The description may or may not include the word Open.
- 5 Entry for the finals can only be made by sending the official duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form.

This Show is a qualifier for **The NPS Summer Championship Show** on 3-5 August 2011. Classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Standard members will be required to upgrade to Full membership to enter the Final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, and then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

A Silver Medal Rosette. These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded where the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider/handlers possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or steward. If the owner of the champion pony is not a member or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the reserve champion provided they have the required membership card. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the reserve champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosettes and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championship. A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the NPS for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Kilmannan Stud M & M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in Malvern or at the Championship Show in Scotland. You may only compete in one Kilmannan Final.
