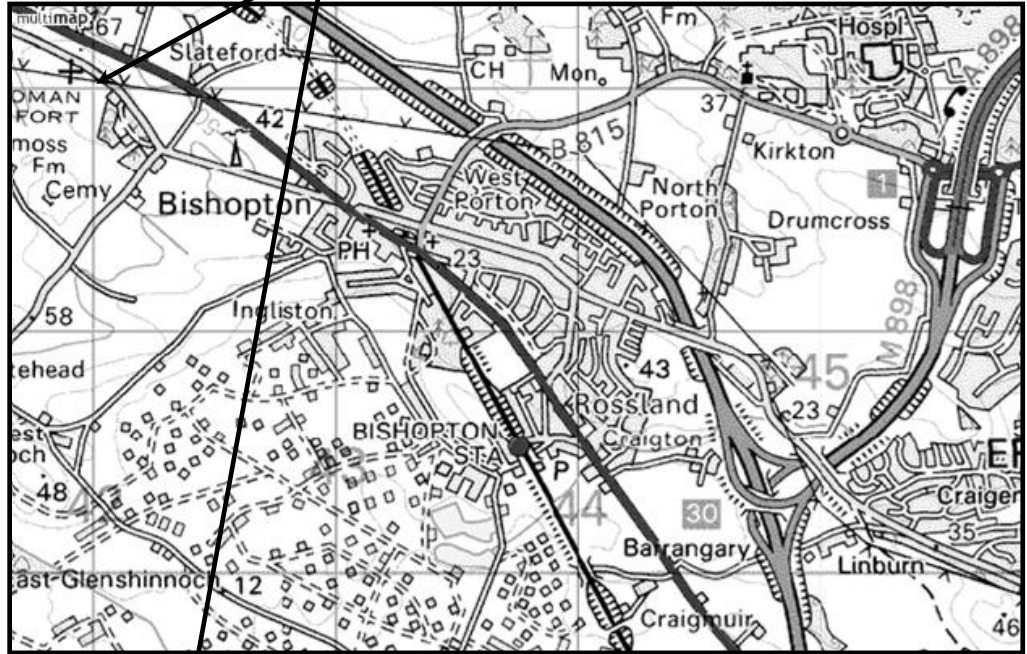

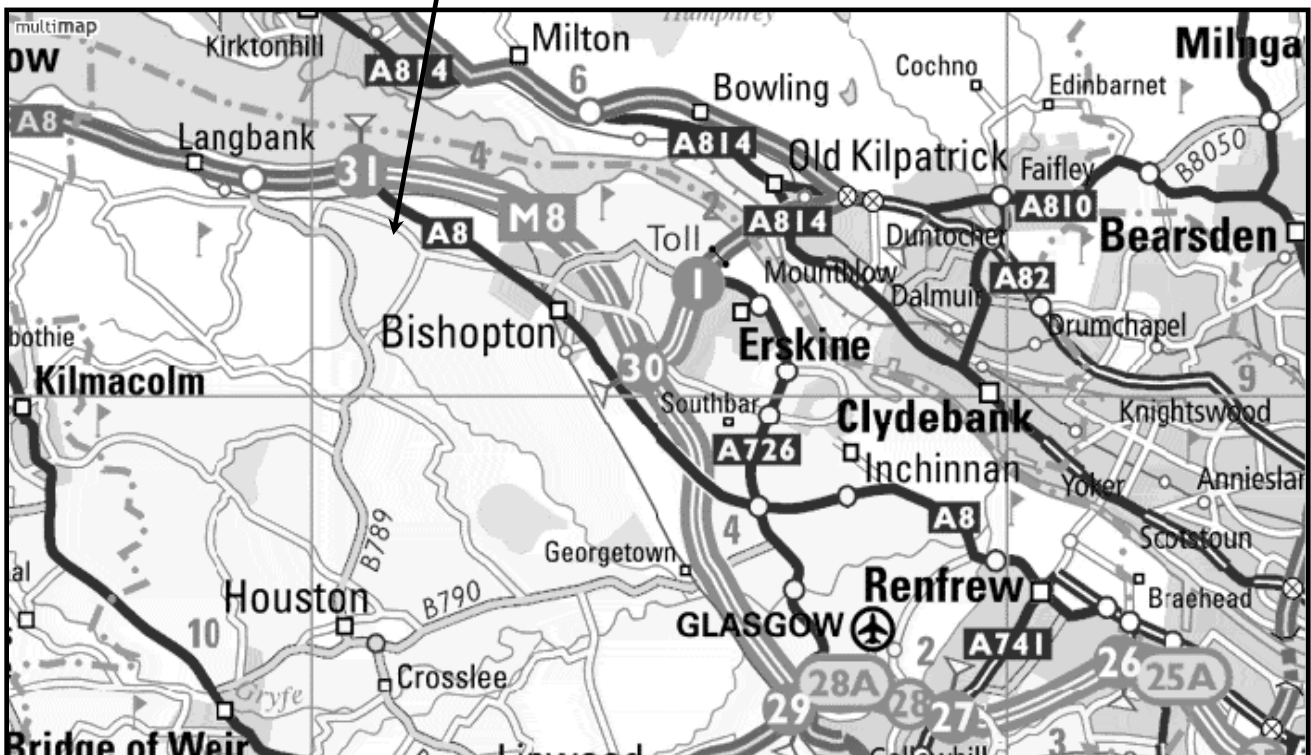
DIRECTIONS TO Ingliston Country Club

AFFILIATION RULES & NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure they are conversant with the rules of the relevant governing Society.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW, HICKSTEAD 28th July to 1st August 2010

This Show is a qualifier for the Royal International Horse Show. The Small, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Amateur and Working Hunter, Small & Large Hacks, Small & Large Riding Horses and Lightweight, Heavyweight & Maxi Cobs, and the BSPS Pretty Polly classes are qualifiers. See below for qualification criteria in each section.

SPORTS HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN

This Show is affiliated to SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN and all Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's 2010 Rules.

- The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Working Hunter and Amateur Hunter classes (2,3,4,5,6,39) are qualifying events for this year's **Royal International Horse Show** (28th July to 1st August 2010), and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. The three highest placed horses in the Amateur Ridden and Working Hunter Hunter class will qualify.
- The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes are also qualifiers for **The National Hunter Supreme Championship Show** to be held at Addington Manor on 7th & 8th September 2010, with the 1st, 2nd & 3rd horses in each class qualifying for the final.
- Horses entered in Class 1, Novice Hunter must be registered on the Basic Identity Register, and not have won a first prize of £60 or a total of £200 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad, before 1st January in the current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old. Any horse that qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show in a Ridden Hunter Class (not including Working Hunter Classes) will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and for the RIHS qualifying classes, owners and riders must be members of the Society. The Society offers a Temporary Registration to competitors who wish to compete at THREE qualifying show for a fee of £10 per show (*Horses need to be on the Basic Identity Register before they can be on the Show Register or have a Temporary Registration*). If the horse subsequently qualifies then they will need to complete their full registration before the Championship Show for which the horse has qualified and the £10 fee will be refunded.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

(formerly British Show Hack, Cob & Riding Horse Association)

This Show is affiliated to the BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION and the Hack, Riding Horse and Cob classes will be held under the Rules and jurisdiction of the British Show Horse Association. These classes are restricted to animals registered with the Association. (*Day ticket membership can be purchased for entry into the Novice classes only*)

- The first placed horse in each of Small & Large Hack, Small & Large Riding Horse and Lightweight & Heavyweight Cob classes (10 - 15) will qualify to enter at the RIHS, if the first horse has already qualified, the second will qualify. If the first and second have already qualified then the third place will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. In the RIHS Maxi Cob classes (Class 16) the first 3 exhibitors will qualify.
- The first, second and third placed horse in the Open Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes (10 - 15) will qualify for the Classic Supreme classes at the British Show Horse Championship Show in September 2010.
- The Rising Stars Championships 2010. Open to competitors in the Intermediate Show Riding Type and Show Hunter Type classes (classes 20 & 27). The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed winners will qualify to compete in this Championship to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show at Addington Manor EC, Bucks on 10th & 11th September 2010. The Final will be split into two classes: 1) The Rising Stars Intermediate Hack of the Year, 2) The Rising Stars Intermediate Riding Horse of the Year

At Affiliated Shows no horse may compete in Hack & Riding Horse Classes at the same show, nor may a horse compete in a Hunter class if it has also competed as a Hack or Riding Horse.

THE BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE

The Show is a Qualifier for the **BLUE CHIP & IDHS(GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE**. The Qualifier will be the highest placed horse (not already qualified) from Classes 1-6,12-16,39 that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, i.e. *with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding*. The horse need not be registered to qualify but **MUST** be on the IDHS(GB) registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show on 18th & 19th September 2010 at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire. **NB: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered.** Each Qualifier will receive a rosette and £10 voucher from Blue Chip. IN THE FINAL, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Trophy and Blue Chip rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred will receive a Trophy and £100 and the highest placed 15.2hh and Under will receive a Trophy and £50.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS (Affiliation No: 2749S/2010) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

- This Show is a qualifier for the 2010 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK, Grantham on 25th to 30th August 2010. The 1st and 2nd prizewinners only in Classes 17,18,23-26, 37, 41-43 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in Classes 20,27,33,36,40, 57 & 58 and the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners in Classes 19, 34,38,59 & 60 will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 23. Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the championship they qualify for.

- **ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW** This show is a qualifier for the Royal International Horse Show. Only one pony in each of the Pretty Polly Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony, Pretty Polly 133cm SHP & the Pretty Polly Mixed Height SHP will qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first five ponies in each class will qualify.
- **BSPS CHALLENGE** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, the highest placed pony in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony, Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH and the Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes that has not qualified for the 2010 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the CHALLENGE.
- **BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE** This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify in the Open Lead Rein & First Ridden Show Ponies, the Open Ridden Show Pony, the Lead Rein of Hunter Type, the Open Show Hunter Ponies, the Intermediate SRT & SH, the Cradle & Nursery Stakes, the Open Working Hunter Ponies, Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden, Open Heritage WHP classes.
- **BSPS CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Open Show Pony (if the class is split), Champion Mini WHP, the Champion SHP, the Champion Open WHP/WH, the Champion Mini Heritage (and the Champion Ridden & WHP Heritage classes should they be split) will qualify.
- **BSPS BEST RIDER** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Mixed Height Show Pony, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open First Ridden Hunter

Pony, Open 122cm, 133cm, 143cm & 153cm SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Open Heritage Ridden and WHP classes (eligible riders must wear an armband) will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show.

TULLIBARDINE WORKING HUNTER PONY FINALS

This show is a qualifying round for the Blair Castle Tullibardine Contractors Working Hunter Pony Series: Ponies placed first to fourth in the qualifying classes (classes 41 to 43) will qualify for the Championships held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 26th August 2010. Qualification may go down to sixth place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified. *Please note the change to the rules, in that ponies no longer need to have jumped a clear round.*

NPS SCOTLAND QUALIFIERS

This show is a qualifying round for the NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Ridden M&M Championship (the 2 Highest placed **eligible** ponies not already qualified from Class 59 will qualify), NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden M&M Championship (the 2 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from Class 60 will qualify) and the NPS Scotland/Lynch Homes M&M WHP Championship (the 3 Highest placed ponies not already qualified from Class 35 will qualify) to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 27th August 2010. The rules for these competitions are as follows:

1. Ponies may only qualify once for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred and X registered ponies and Eriskays are not eligible.
3. Qualification can go as far down the line as necessary.
4. For Novice classes. Ponies must wear a snaffle bridle & must not have won a 1st in an open ridden mixed M. & M. or breed class prior to Jan 1st 2010. An open class is one for Registered Ponies that does not mention Junior, Novice, Intermediate, Lead Rein or 1st Ridden in its description. *(as these classes are judged under BSPS rules, the highest placed unqualified may not be eligible under NPS rules, so the qualification will go down the line as far as the first eligible pony)*
5. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card, duly signed by the judge at the time of qualifying, with your entry form.
6. The **OWNER** must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
7. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class. (selected Shows only)
8. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 27th August 2010.
(Should any of the above classes be split on the day, only one pony from each section will qualify, in the case of the Ridden classes, should they be split to more than 2 classes then a championship will be held and the Champion & Reserve will qualify)

CHAPS(UK) CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

This Show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both the owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS(UK) nor must the horse/pony be registered with CHAPS(UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both Showing Members and the horse/pony be registered with the society BEFORE this Show for the qualification to be valid. Membership Cards and Qualification Cards must be produced in the ring and the latter signed by the judge in two places. These classes are also qualifiers for the Ponies UK Summer Championships, please refer to your CHAPS(UK) Members Handbook or www.chapsuk.com for full details.

The CHAPS(UK) Championship Show will be held on 3rd 4th & 5th September 2010. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS(UK) for appropriate qualifier card. Ponies UK Summer Championships will be held on 11th-14th August 2010.

Classes 46 -50 are Qualifying classes which enable eligible exhibits to enter the relevant classes at the CHAPS(UK) Championship Show in the year relevant to the qualification. Separate Finals will be held at the Championship Show for Yearlings, Two Year Olds, Three Year Olds and for Natives and Non-Natives (Ridden and In-Hand) together with Ridden Finals for Lead Rein and First Ridden.

All Stallions entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS(UK). ID Cards must be carried in the ring for inspection. Foals born in the current year are not eligible to compete in qualifying classes.

VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY

This Show is an Area Qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society. Classes 44 & 45 are qualifiers for the Regional Qualifier, which in turn is a qualifier for Olympia. Please see further details after Class 45 in this schedule.

EX-RACERS CLUB SCOTTISH CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the above Championship to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Sunday 29th August 2010. All horses must be registered with the Ex Racers Club. Registration (once in a lifetime fee of £10) forms can be found at www.exracersclub.com. In classes 51 & 52 all horses placed 1st to 4th will qualify for the Scottish Ex Racers Club Champion of Champions classes at Blair Castle Horse Trials.

BLAIR CASTLE RIDDEN CLYDESDALE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Class 56 is a qualifier for the Blair Castle Ridden Clydesdale Championships to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Sunday 29th August 2010. Registered horses and horses of Clydesdale type only. The first two will qualify, and the qualification can go down to 4th place if the horses placed 1st and 2nd have previously qualified.

THE MASTERS

This Show is a qualifier for the The Masters to be held at Kingsbarn Equestrian Centre, Falkirk on 30th September to 3rd October 2010. The first four to qualify, not already qualified within the first six placed in each of the following classes: 1-43, 48- 50, 53-55 & 57-60

NOVICE DEFINITIONS

- BSPS:** A Pony of six years old and over that has three BSPS Affiliated Open or Restricted Open or Pretty Polly Open wins where there is a first prize of £5 or over or placed 1st – 5th at RIHS or HOYS in a particular class is no longer eligible for Novice in that particular class for the remainder of its career.
- NPS:** A novice pony is one that has not won a 1st place in either an Open Mixed Mountain & Moorland or breed ridden class prior to 1st January 2010 (those not eligible under NPS Rules, may still compete in the BSPS Novice Heritage class, but may not qualify for the NPS Novice Finals at Blair Castle)
- SHB(GB):** Novice Hunter must not have won a first prize of £60 or a total of £200 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Ridden Hunter Classes at home or abroad, before 1st January in the current year, excepting all prize money awarded as a four year old.
- BSHA:** A Novice is a Hack, Cob or Riding Horse that has not won a first prize of £25 or more, or more than a total of £100 in showing classes, excluding Working Cobs, working Riding Horse, Best Trained, Pairs or Side Saddle classes that were affiliated to the Association at home or abroad, prior to 1st January 2010. Winnings as a four year old excepted unless that four year old has won an open class. Snaffles may be worn in novice classes. *(further detailed rules are available under Rule 7e, Page 10 of the 2010 Rule Book)*

REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

HUNTERS: Owners & riders must be Member of SHB(GB) & horses must be on the 2010 Show Hunter Register or be in possession of a Day Ticket to compete in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight & Working Hunter and Amateur Ridden Hunter classes (2 -6, 38). Horses entered in the Novice Hunter (class 1) must be recorded on the Basic Identity Register (once in a lifetime registration). Neither Owner nor Rider are required to be a member of SHB(GB) to compete in the novice hunter class.

HACKS, COBS & RIDING HORSES: Owners and riders must be a Member of British Horse Association and horses must be registered for the current season to compete in the RIHS Hack, Riding Horse and Cob (incl Maxi Cobs) classes 10-16). Entries can be made for the Novice Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes (7,8,9) with either full registration/membership or on purchase of a Day Ticket at £15.

BSPS PRETTY POLLY: Owners and riders must be members of BSPS and ponies registered for the 2010 season to compete in these classes (classes 28 – 32)

EX-RACEHORSES: must be registered with Ex-Racers Club to enter and compete. This cost is a once in a lifetime fee of £10.

All other classes are open to all competitors and no annual membership/registration to any society is required to enter or compete. In all M&M classes all animals must be registered in their relevant Breed Society Stud Book.

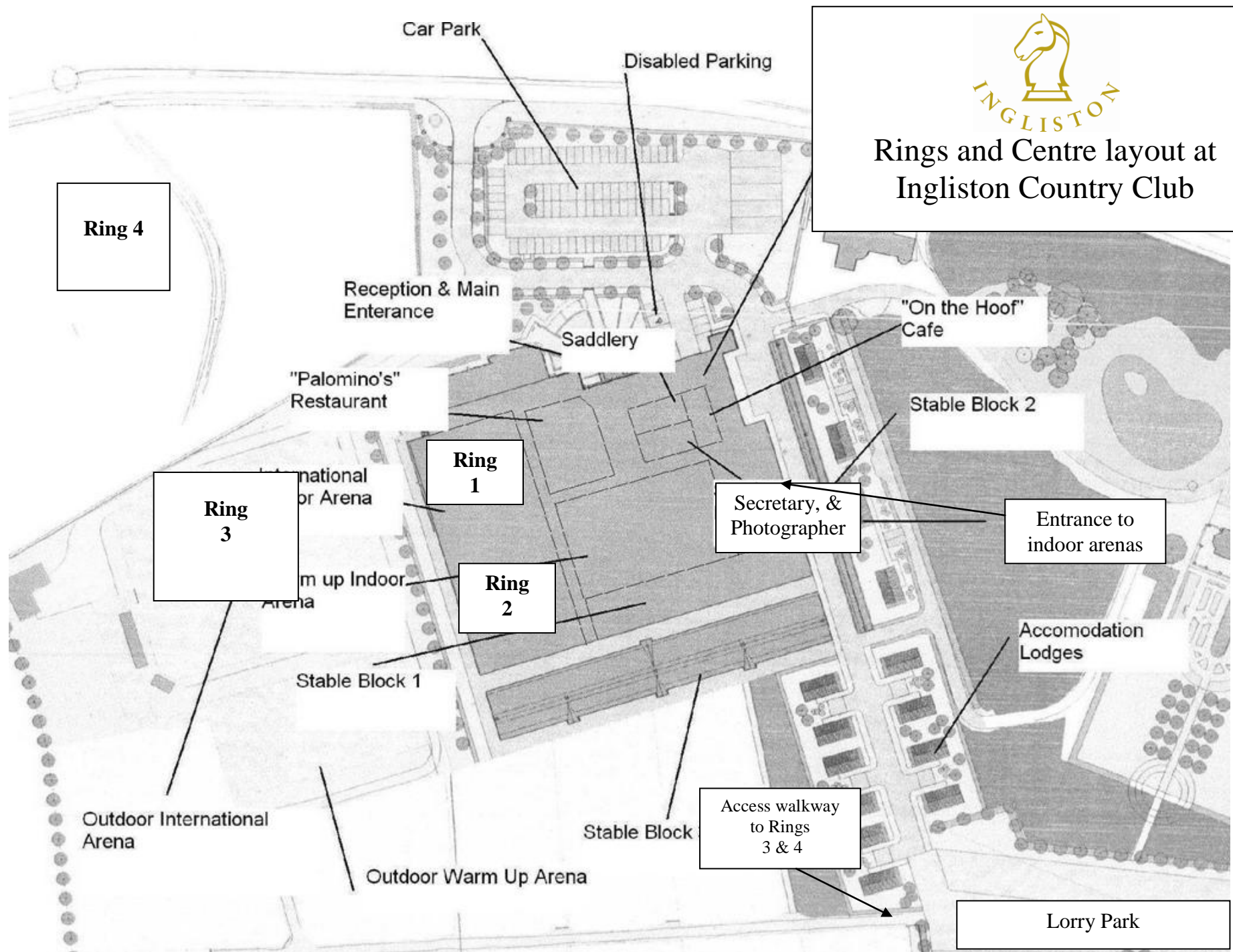
