PONIES / HORSES

All Classes Open to Non - BSPS Members

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("BSPS") (Affiliation No. 7S-11) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge. The highest placed pony in Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128cm, 138cm and 148cm Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Show hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes. 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Working Hunter Pony and the Intermediate SRT, SH and WH that has not already qualified for the BSPS 2011 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, open Lead Rein show hunter type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms, and 153cms WHP, the Inter.SRT, SH and WH classes will receive a card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2011 BSPS Championship Show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes, 13,14,15,18,19,40,41,42,43,48,49,50,52 and the highest placed 133cm in the 138cm Show Pony Class and the highest placed 143cm in the 148cm Show Pony class. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in classes 11,38,47,53. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in 12,37,46,56 will qualify for the BSPS Summer Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member

This Show is a qualifier for the "BSPS Premier League", the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies in the Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128cm, 138cm and 148cm Show Pony. Lead Rein Hunter Type, 122cm, 133cm, 143cm, and 153cm Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, 133cm, 143cm and 153cm, Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter and Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage WHP.

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Mini WHP, the Champion Open Show Pony, the Champion WHP/WH, the Champion Open SHP and the first prizewinner in the Heritage WHP.

Rule 23. Ponies must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, provided they have a valid J M B certificate before the date of the championships they qualify for.

BSPS rosettes will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion Show Pony, WHP, SHP, Mini Show Pony and Mini WHP at affiliated shows, providing the pony is registered, owned and ridden by a member of the BSPS.

Blair Castle Tullibardine Contractors Open Working Hunter Pony Championship. Classes 47, 48, 49, 50 are qualifiers. Ponies placed first to fourth in each class will qualify for the Championships held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 18th August 2011. Qualification may go down to 6th place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified.

Riders not to have attained their 16th birthday before 1st January in the current year. 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in classes 12, 13 and 14 not eligible. Entry Money £5. 1st Kirkland Cup and £10, 2nd £5, 3rd £3
- 18 BSPS Leading Rein Pony (Mare or Gelding) 4 Years Old and Over, not exceeding 122cm (12hh). Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 19 BSPS First Ridden Pony (Mare or Gelding) 4 Years Old and Over not exceeding 122cm (12hh). Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 20 **Mini Show Pony Championship.** Open to ponies that have been placed 1st and 2nd in classes 18 and 19. The Champion will qualify for the BSPS Champion of Champions. Winner to receive the McGowan Quaich presented by ICI Nobel's Explosives Co. Ltd.

Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered in the NPS Stud Book or registered in the main body of their respective breeds. Mountain and Moorland ponies are restricted to the heights laid down by the appropriate breed society. All stallions and colts, two years old and over must be in possession of a current society license. For Shetlands, Highlands, Dales and Exmoor ponies this is extended to three years old and over.

- 23 Mountain and Moorland First Ridden (Mare or Gelding) 4 Years Old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle acceptable.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 2nd – 4th September 2011. Shows held on or after the date of the Championship Show will count as 2012 qualifiers. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier cards. Ponies (UK) Summer Championships will be held on 10th-13th August 2011.

- 45 Working Hunter. (Mare or Gelding) 4 Years old and over exceeding 153cm. Height of fences not to exceed 95cm. Winner to receive the Marina Challenge Trophy.
Jumping phase only to take place in ring 6, then the conformation will be judged in ring 3B.
- 46 BSPS mixed height novice W.H.P/Intermediate WH. (Mare or Gelding) 4 years Old or Over, not exceeding 158cm. Riders must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153 cm or the Intermediate Section.
